# **APPLICATION**

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), pursuant to KRS 278.018(6), 807 KAR 5:001 Section 14, and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22, hereby applies for approval of changes in its certified service territory as agreed to with Clark Energy Cooperative, Inc. ("Clark Energy").

- 1. KU's mailing address is Kentucky Utilities Company, Post Office Box 32010, 220 West Main Street, Louisville, Kentucky 40202. KU may be reached by electronic mail at the electronic mail addresses of its counsel set forth below.
- 2. KU was incorporated in Kentucky on August 17, 1912, and in Virginia on November 26, 1991 (and effective as of December 1, 1991), and is in good standing in both Kentucky and Virginia.
- 3. KU is a public utility, as defined in KRS 278.010(3)(a), engaged in the electric business. KU generates and purchases electricity, and distributes and sells electricity at retail in the following counties in Central, Northern, Southeastern, and Western Kentucky:

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5. <u>Description of Changes in Service Territory</u>: As explained in this application and in the attached exhibits, KU and Clark Energy have individually agreed to the requested territorial change, which clarifies certain territorial boundaries off Hedger Lane in far eastern Fayette County. The proposed territorial boundary change involves three properties – 4232 Hedger Lane, 4246 Hedger Lane, and a new water pump station for the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government ("LFUCG"). The pump station does not yet have a physical address.

When LFUCG requested service, the parties discovered that KU had been inadvertently serving both 4232 and 4246 Hedger Lane for approximately 16 years outside of KU's certified service territorial boundary. KU believes this mistake was made due to mapping inaccuracies during the initial time period when the customers requested service. To remedy this recently-discovered issue, KU and Clark Energy propose to officially extend KU's service territory boundary to include both 4232 and 4246 Hedger Lane and for KU to cede to Clark Energy the service territory at Hedger Lane that includes the new pumping station. Clark Energy has an existing 3-phase primary line that could meet LFUCG's need for new service to the pumping station. The requested territorial change will serve the purposes of KRS 278.016 by avoiding unnecessary encumbrance of the landscape and duplication of facilities and minimizing disputes between retail electric suppliers. The territorial maps and other attachments provided constitute the entire agreement between KU and Clark Energy.

# 6. Agreement and Maps:

Application Exhibit 1 of this filing includes the summary list identifying KU and Clark Energy personnel familiar with the specifics of the facilities available, the reason for the change and purposes served under KRS 278.016, and copies of the territorial (quadrant) map, detail map, and agreement signed by both parties for the properties involved.

WHEREFORE, KU hereby requests, pursuant to KRS 278.018, that the Commission enter an order approving the updates to the Quadrant Map to reflect the current requested service territory change and the agreement between KU and Clark Energy.

## AGREEMENT


Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) and Clark Energy Cooperative (Clark) hereby agree to two territorial boundary changes. Both are located off Hedger Lane in eastern Fayette County, Kentucky. Anomalies were discovered, therefore the utilities request Commission approval to rectify the boundaries via a territorial change filing in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001 Section 14.


The first change would have KU continuing to serve 4232 Hedger Lane and 4246 Hedger Lane. KU has served the addresses for approximately 16.5 years.
