**PLAN FOR REFUND**

---

In its December 19, 2019, Order, the Commission ordered the City of Pikeville “file with the Commission a report on the amount of excess revenues collected from September 5, 2019, through the date of this Order and a plan for refunding these revenues. Pikeville, by counsel, provides the following response to that ordering paragraph.

Based on a comparison of the proposed rate of \$2.30 per 1,000 gallons and a rate of \$1.97 per 1,000 gallons, Pikeville collected an additional \$34,955.25 from Mountain Water District (“MWD”). Interest on payments received by MWD at a rate of 1.68% APR would total \$94.49. Accordingly, Pikeville will credit MWD the amount of \$35,049.73 on the next invoice issued on or about February 1, 2020. (The calculation is provided in an Attachment to this filing.)

Pikeville reserves the right to collect additional amounts from MWD based on consumption on and after September 5, 2019, pending the outcome of Pikeville’s Petition for Rehearing and related matters. Because the Commission cannot order a rate be retroactively changed, Pikeville has no legal obligation to refund any amounts to Southern Water and Sewer District.
