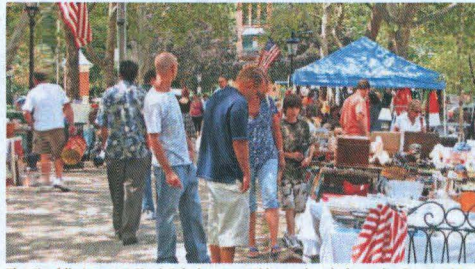

Pandemic won't stop the World's Longest Yard Sale

The World's Longest Yard Sale is still happening this weekend despite the pandemic.

Officials with the 127 Yard Sale said the event started on Thursday and continues through Sunday. The long-standing event covers 690 miles from Addison, Michigan, to Gadsden, Alabama, and boasts thousands of vendors every year.

The trail winds itself through Northern Kentucky and Greater Cincinnati, drawing crowds to packed parking lots and sidewalks along the route.

"As a mostly outdoor event, there is more than enough space to allow for social distancing at the 127 Yard Sale. With the help of all participants, this event will go on while protecting the safety and health of everyone," officials with 127yardsale.com said.

The 127 Yard Sale, a.k.a. "The World's Longest Yard Sale" travels through six states: Michigan, Ohio, Kentucky, Tennessee, Georgia, and Alabama. The majority of the route follows Highway 127, hence its proper name.

In northern Kentucky, the route follows U.S. 42 and U.S. 25, before recon-

necting with U.S. 127 in Cincinnati. "For the safety of all participants, it is your responsibility to follow state and local guidelines that are in place at the time of the event," officials said.

Officials said there are no states that have tried to cancel the 127 Yard Sale.

"In addition to providing essential outdoor recreation, fun, and enjoyment, this event takes place in mostly rural areas in the states where the route passes through. Many of the vendors who participate earn a significant portion of their yearly income at this event," officials said. "This year more than ever these businesses desperately need the revenue generated during the 127 Yard Sale."

Northern Kentucky Health Department said this weekend's yard sale should follow protective measures against COVID-19 including:

- Social distancing – Stay at least 6 feet away from anyone not living in your same household.
- Wear a Face Covering – These should cover your mouth and nose to help prevent the spread of the virus through respiratory droplets.
- Keep hand sanitizer available so that it can be used frequently between hand washings.
- Do not handle items that you are not going to purchase.

Greenacres mulls proposals for Gamble house property

'All proposals have merits'

Developers are pitching proposals to build subdivisions and recreational projects on land where the historic Gamble house in Westwood used to stand. The Greenacres Foundation, which owns the 22-acre property at 2918 Werk Road, asked the Home Builders Association of Greater Cincinnati and other interested parties earlier this summer to submit proposals and purchase prices by Aug. 1.

"We got several proposals from developers/builders to put in a subdivision of varying density. We also received a proposal that the property would become a park and one to make an event center," Greenacres President Carter Randolph said.

"We are not revealing anything more about the proposals and we will work through them and see if we think there is one that stands out."

The house was torn down in 2013, to the dismay of some neighbors and preservationists, and is at the center of a court battle that is still being fought.

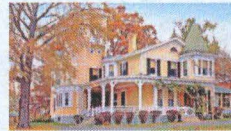
The Gamble house, a Victorian mansion with a section that stood for more than 170 years, once was owned by James N. Gamble, son of a founder of Procter & Gamble and the creator of Ivory soap.

The residential-zoned property has a cottage, two barns and remnants of a greenhouse on it.

The Greenacres Foundation, a non-profit education, research and preservation group based in Indian Hill, decided to give up the property after dropping 10-year-old plans to develop an environmental and agricultural education center for children there.

The property's zoning would allow construction of one house per 10,000 square feet of land, Randolph said. Greenacres thinks the property is worth as much as 2 million.

The foundation doesn't expect to decide on the sale of the property until the beginning of next year.
