Applicants' Motion for Informal Conference

Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company, LLC, P.R. Wastewater Management, Inc., Marshall County Environmental Services LLC, LH Treatment Company, LLC, Kingswood Development, Inc., Airview Utilities, LLC, Brocklyn Utilities, LLC, Fox Run Utilities, LLC, and Lake Columbia Utilities, Inc. (collectively, "Applicants") hereby move for an informal conference in this matter, to be held next week if possible. In support of this motion, Applicants state as follows:

1. In their Joint Application, the Applicants provided the information required for a transfer/acquisition application and to show that the proposed acquisition and transfer of ownership and control of assets meet the requirements of KRS 278.020(6), (7), and (10). They anticipate, however, that the Commission, its Staff, and the Attorney General of the Common-wealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention ("AG") may have questions about the proposed transactions or would like to have other additional information.

2. Holding an informal conference early in the 60-day period allowed by KRS 278.020(7) would expedite the proceedings and more efficiently use the resources of the

Commission and the parties. Such a conference could demonstrate the sufficiency of the information already filed or identify what further information should be filed or will be sought through information requests.

3. Applicants suggest that the informal conference would not take more than two (2) hours, and that there should be provision for participation by telephone, given the number of Applicant parties and their locations.

4. The AG representative for this case (Kent A. Chandler) has indicated that he would be available to participate in an informal conference on Wednesday, May 15, 2019 (anytime) and Thursday, May 16, 2019 (except between 11:00 A.M. and 2:00 P.M.). Applicants ask for an informal conference to be scheduled on those days/times if possible. If not possible, Applicants ask for an informal conference the following week (May 20-24, 2019) on a day and time feasible for key participants among the Applicants.

WHEREFORE, Applicants respectfully request scheduling of an informal conference in this matter, to be held if possible on May 15 or 16, 2019, as more fully explained in ¶ 4 above.
