APPLICATION

Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Energy Kentucky), pursuant to KRS 278.018(6) and 807 KAR 5:001 Section 14, hereby applies for approval of changes in certified service territory as agreed with Owen County Electric Cooperative (Owen Electric).

1. The full name and mailing address is: Duke Energy Kentucky, 139 E. Fourth Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202. The Company's local office in Kentucky is Duke Energy Envision Center, 4580 Olympic Boulevard, Erlanger, Kentucky 41018. Duke Energy Kentucky can also be reached at the electronic mail address of its counsel set forth below.

2. Duke Energy Kentucky is a utility engaged in the gas and electric business. Duke Energy Kentucky purchases, sells, stores and transports natural gas in Boone, Bracken, Campbell, Gallatin, Grant, Kenton and Pendleton Counties, Kentucky. Duke Energy Kentucky also generates electricity, which it distributes and sells in Boone, Campbell, Grant, Kenton and Pendleton Counties.

3. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14(2), Duke Energy Kentucky states that it was originally incorporated in the Commonwealth of Kentucky on March 20, 1901, and attests that it is currently in good standing in said Commonwealth. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14(2), a certified copy of Duke Energy Kentucky's certificate of good standing from the Kentucky Secretary of State and a certificate for the following assumed name: "Duke Energy." is on file with the Kentucky Secretary of State and on file with the Commission in Case No. 2017-00321.

4. Description of Changes in Service Territory: Duke Energy Kentucky and Owen Electric have individually agreed to the requested territorial change. The territorial boundary change is requested for a lot where the owner is constructing a garage behind his residence at 6105 Elwood Road, in Burlington, Boone County, Kentucky. The re-alignment of the territory is due to proximity of the two utilities performing installation of utility service, Owen Electric three phase pole is in closer proximity to the lot whereupon the garage is to be constructed than the those of the Duke Energy Kentucky facilities. The service territory change will provide the customer with a more economic solution to add three phase service to his proposed garage. This requested change will serve the purposes of KRS 278.016 by avoiding unnecessary encumbering of the landscape and the duplication of facilities, as well as minimizing disputes between electric suppliers. The territorial maps provided constitute the entire agreement between Duke Energy Kentucky and Owen Electric.



WHEREFORE, Duke Energy Kentucky hereby requests, pursuant to KRS 278.018, that the Commission enter its order approving the service territory changes and Agreements allocating these electric services as agreed to by the parties. Due to size and scale of the maps, Duke Energy Kentucky requests the Commission to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001 Section 7 and permit Duke Energy Kentucky to file only two complete sets of maps.




Re: 6105 Elwood Ave. Burlington KY 41005 Service Territory Boundary change, (New pole barn only)

Mr. Maxwell Kincart (property owner: 6105 Elwood Ave. Parcels 038.09-00-015.00) has requested a three phase service for the new pole barn near the rear of his parcel. This request would require significant Duke Energy work to upgrade the existing single phase line that serves Elwood Ave; replacement of poles and wire. The required Duke Energy work will not revenue justify, resulting in a large lump sum charge or large X-Rider monthly payment.

Owen Electric has an existing three phase pole line that runs near the back side of Mr. Kincart's property, which can provide him with his requested service. Mr. Kincart has made contact with Owen Electric and they are able to meet his needs. Mr. Kincart has also made arrangements with adjoining property owner; James Rudicill (Parcel 038.09-00-016.00).

Duke Energy, Kentucky Inc. approves a service boundary change for the new pole barn near the rear of Parcels (038.09-015.00). If you are in agreement with the description of the above mentioned Service Territory Boundary change, please have a copy of this letter (and land base drawing) signed, dated, and returned to me as authorization to proceed. This letter and accompanying drawing will then be submitted to the Utility Commission for a service territory boundary change.
