

Big Rivers Electric Corporation
2025 Low-Income Weatherization Support Program Report
Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of
Commission’s November 13, 2019 Order

2025 Program Summary

Big Rivers Electric Corporation’s (“Big Rivers”) Low-Income Weatherization Support Program (“LIWSP”) (DSM-14 – Low-Income Weatherization Support Program – Pilot) received two project requests in 2025 from Audubon Area Community Services expected to be completed in 2026. Big Rivers anticipates increased activity in 2026 based on discussions with the Kentucky Housing Corp (“KHC”) and the Community Action Agencies (“CAAs”)

KHC provides funding coordination to the CAAs, which serve retail members of Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation (“JPEC”), Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (“Meade County RECC”) and Kenergy Corp. Those CAAs are:

- West Kentucky Allied Services,
- Pennyrile Allied Community Services,
- Audubon Area Community Services, and
- Central Kentucky Community Action.

KHC staff has reminded the CAAs’ weatherization programs of the availability of funding for weatherization projects in 2026. Big Rivers has received inquiries and will be educating individual CCA weatherization managers about the program.
