

Big Rivers Electric Corporation
2023 Low-Income Weatherization Support Program Report
Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of
Commission’s November 13, 2019 Order

2023 Program Summary

Big Rivers Electric Corporation’s (“Big Rivers”) Low-Income Weatherization Support Program (“LIWSP”) (DSM-14 – Low-Income Weatherization Support Program – Pilot) had no activity in 2023. The program received no requests for participation in 2023. During coordination conference calls, staff from the Kentucky Housing Corp (“KHC”), explained that the lack of participation is due to availability of alternative funding through the USDOE’s Weatherization Ready program. KHC provides funding coordination to the Community Action Agencies (“CAAs”) which serve retail members of Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation (“JPEC”), Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (“Meade County RECC”) and Kenergy Corp. Those CAAs are:

- West Kentucky Allied Services,
- Pennyrile Allied Community Services,
- Audubon Area Community Services, and
- Central Kentucky Community Action.

KHC staff suggested that funding of Weatherization Ready in the next year may wane, resulting in potential projects for 2024.
