

Big Rivers Electric Corporation
2022 Low-Income Weatherization Support Program Report
Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of
Commission’s November 13, 2019 Order

2022 Program Summary

Big Rivers Electric Corporation’s (“Big Rivers”) Low-Income Weatherization Support Program (“LIWSP”) (DSM-14 – Low-Income Weatherization Support Program – Pilot) had no activity in 2022. During coordination conference calls with staff from the Kentucky Housing Corp (“KHC”), it was explained that the lack of participation may be due in part to alternative funding very similar to the Big Rivers program becoming available. KHC provides funding coordination to the Community Action Agencies (“CAAs”) which serve retail members of Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation (“JPEC”), Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (“Meade County RECC”) and Kenergy Corp. Those CAAs are:

- West Kentucky Allied Services,
- Pennyrile Allied Community Services,
- Audubon Area Community Services, and
- Central Kentucky Community Action.

The program received no requests for participation in 2022. Big Rivers’ conversations with KHC are ongoing to evaluate potential projects for 2023.
