LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY’S
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION FOR A STATE WAIVER
OF THE REASSESSMENT INTERVAL OF MULTIPLE PIPELINES

Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E), by counsel, hereby respectfully moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for leave to withdraw its application without prejudice. As grounds for this motion, LG&E states that is has now confirmed usable data has been obtained from the geometry and MFL-A ILI tool runs within the high consequence areas on all pipelines which had an integrity assessment due this year. As a result, the requested waiver is no longer needed, and the application can be withdrawn.

WHEREFORE, Louisville Gas and Electric Company respectfully states that it no longer requires an extension of time to conduct its reassessment under § 192.943, and asks the Commission to grant this Motion to withdraw the request.
