REQUEST:

Refer to Duke Kentucky's response to Staff's First Request, Item 20.

- a. Provide a copy of the Kevin Costello letter referenced in this response.
- b. Provide copies of the letters that were sent to property owners within 500 feet of the proposed transmission route.
- c. Provide the nature of the information requests that was sought by the two property referenced in this response and state whether Duke Kentucky adequately responded to those requests. Provide a copy of any written responses that Duke Kentucky provided addressing the property owners' additional information requests.

SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE:

Since receiving the Kevin Costello letter referenced above, Duke Energy Kentucky has met with Boone County twice in person to present and discuss options to mitigate the concerns the comments and concerns expressed in the letter. Based on these discussions, Duke Energy is incorporating design measures at Oakbrook and Woodspoint substations to reduce the aesthetic impacts. The Company is developing visual simulations to communicate with the Boone County and will continue to work with the County to address their concerns. In addition, a new customer to be served is also leading the development of a solution on the land it will own/lease in between the proposed Aero substation and Aero Parkway in coordination with both Boone County and Duke Energy Kentucky.
