<u>Contractor</u> into Contractor's trucks, hauled by Contractor from Owner's secondary dewatering (SDW) laydown area, to Owner's landfill, located on Green Station plant property in Webster County, Kentucky, and placed in the landfill in compliance with applicable governmental laws, regulations, and the accompanying specification and drawings, and

WHEREAS, Contractor desires to provide its services to Owner by loading the solid waste into trucks, hauling the solid waste from Owner's secondary dewatering (SDW) laydown area to Owner's landfill, placing and covering solid waste in the landfill and performing related work in accordance with applicable governmental laws, regulations, and the accompanying specification and drawings, and

WHEREAS, Owner desires to engage the services of Contractor for loading, hauling, placement, and covering of solid waste and related work, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to set forth their mutual understandings and covenants with regard to the loading, hauling, placement and covering of solid waste;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants stated in this contract and in the contract documents (as defined herein), Owner and Contractor agree as follows:

1. <u>DESCRIPTION OF WORK</u> Contractor will perform all work as shown in the contract documents for the execution of this Solid Waste Landfill Service Contract.

2. <u>CONTRACT CONTROL AND RESPONSIBILITY</u>. The Plant Superintendent of the R. D. Green electric generating facility, or his designated representative, employed by Big Rivers Electric Corporation

WHEREAS, owner has examined all bids submitted and awarded the contract to the Contractor on the basis that his bid contains the lowest evaluated bid price.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this contract be executed setting out the mutual rights and duties of the parties in the performance of the contract.

WITNESSETH: That Owner and Contractor, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, agree as follows:

WHEREAS, Owner owns and Big Rivers Electric Corporation, (herein after referred to as OPERATOR), operates the Henderson Municipal Power & Light Station Two Power Plant near Sebree, Kentucky (hereinafter referred to as "Owner's Plant"), produces at Owner's Plant solid waste materials (1) a mixture of the waste from the flue gas desulfurization system and the fly ash from the boiler, (2) the bottom ash from the boiler, and (3) other customary power plant materials acceptable for placement in landfill owned by Big Rivers Electric Corporation, (these materials hereinafter referred to collectively as the "solid waste"; the landfill hereinafter referred to as the "Operator's landfill"), and desires to have said solid waste loaded by Contractor into Contractor's trucks, hauled by Contractor from Owner's secondary dewatering (SDW) laydown area, to Operator's landfill, located on Green Station plant property in Webster County, Kentucky, and placed in the landfill in compliance with applicable governmental laws, regulations, and the accompanying specification and drawings, and
