Pursuant to the Kentucky Public Service Commission’s Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(3), I hereby certify that I am Andrea M. Fackler, Manager, Revenue Requirement/Cost of Service, for Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E” or “Company”), a utility furnishing retail electric and gas service within the Commonwealth of Kentucky, which, on the 27th day of September 2019, filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for the approval of an amended gas line tracker, and that notice to the public of the issuing of the same has been completed as described below.



Publication of this notice is now complete. An affidavit from Kentucky Press confirming this publication and a copy of said notice are attached as Exhibit A. The Kentucky Press has presented to

LG&E proof of this publication of notice in the form of “tear sheets,” which LG&E will maintain in its files.

I further certify that on the 27th day of September 2019 the notice to the public was delivered for exhibition and public inspection at 820 West Broadway, Louisville, KY 40202 and that the same will be kept open to public inspection at said office during the pendency of this case.

I further certify that, beginning on 27th day of September 2019, LG&E posted on its website a copy of the notice that 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17 requires and a hyperlink to the location on the Commission’s website where the case documents and tariff filings are available. Beginning on the 27th day of September 2019, LG&E posted on its website a complete copy of its application in this case. The newspaper notice included the web address to the online posting. LG&E’s Application filed with the Commission on the 27th day of September 2019, includes the customer notice as Exhibit 4 to the Application.


