Per the Commission's order from Case No. 2019-00326, dated January 14, 2020, reference page 13, number 3, stating "Jackson Purchase shall notify the Commission prior to performing any additional purchases or renovations not expressly authorized by the Order", Jackson Purchase (JPEC) hereby notifies the Commission of its intent to purchase an adjacent commercial lot located at the main entrance of the new headquarters site in Paducah, Kentucky. The board of JPEC approved this purchase for \$300,000 at its March 30, 2021 Board meeting.

This piece of commercial property, which is approximately 1.5 acres in size, was not available for sale when the original deal commenced, but the JPEC board expressed interest in buying it for some time because of its importance to the new 40-acre headquarters site by providing much easier visibility and access from U.S. Highway 60, a very high-traffic arterial highway in Paducah. The owner of the lot has agreed to JPEC's offer and the agreement is expected to close on or about May 15, 2021. Based upon information available to JPEC, this piece of property last sold to the current owner for \$285,000 in 2014.
