APPLICATION

Pursuant to KRS 278.023, and 807 KAR 5:069, Green River Valley Water District ("Green River District") applies to the Public Service Commission for an Order granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the expansion of its water treatment plant and other waterworks improvements, approving an adjustment of its rates for water service, and authorizing the issuance of \$8,062,000 of revenue bonds.

In support of its Application, 1 Green River District provides the following:

- 2. Green River District not a corporation, limited liability company or limited partnership. It has no articles of incorporation or partnership agreements.

GREEN RIVER VALLEY WATER DISTRICT NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE CHANGE

On or about August 29, 2019, Green River Valley Water District will apply to the Kentucky Public Service Commission for an increase in its rates for water service. The United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development ("RD") has required a change in Green River Valley Water District's rates as a condition to the award of a loan of \$8,062,000, which will be evidenced by waterworks revenue bonds, and a grant of \$3,563,000. RD requires that Green River Valley Water District assess the following rates:

The proposed rates shall be effective for water sold on and after the date of the order of the Public Service Commission approving those rates, which is expected to be no later than 30 days after the filing of the Application.

The proposed rates are required under the terms of an agreement between Green River Valley Water District and RD. KRS 278.023 does not grant the Public Service Commission any discretionary authority to modify or reject any portion of the agreement between Green River Valley Water District and RD, or to defer the issuance of all necessary orders to implement the terms of the agreement.

The proceeds of the RD loan and grant will be used to expand the capacity of Green River Valley Water District's water treatment plant from six million gallons per day to eight million gallons per day, to construct the following improvements: a new river water intake on the Green River for the water treatment plant, a secondary raw water pump station to pump water from Rio Verde Spring, a new chlorine building and feed equipment, two new two-staged flocculation basins and two sedimentation basins, two filters, and a 1,200,000 gallon clearwell. They will also be used for yard piping improvements, refurbishing an existing laboratory, and acquiring and installing a new SCADA system for the water treatment plant and water distribution system.

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-09-09

A RESOLUTION OF LARUE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO.1 ADJUSTING ITS WATER RATES TO OFFSET THE GREEN RIVER VALLEY WATER DISTRICT WHOLESALE RATE INCREASE

WHEREAS, the Green River Valley Water District Valley Water District supplies potable water to Larue County Water District No.1 on a wholesale basis'

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2019 the Green River Valley Water District filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") seeking to increase the wholesale water rate that the Green River Valley Water District charges the Larue County Water District No.1 from \$2.14 to \$2.59 per 1,000 gallons (See PSC Case 2019-00287);

WHEREAS, based upon the water purchases from the Green River Valley Water District during the previous 12 months, the estimated annual increased cost to Larue County Water District No. 1 will be \$ 42,249.77;

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that Larue County

Water District take action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with the Green

River Valley Water District's wholesale rate increase; and

WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068 provides the legal

mechanism for Larue County Water District No. 1 to increase its water rates to commensurate with the Green River Valley Water District's wholesale rate increase via a Purchased Water Adjustment ("PWA")

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LARUE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO.1 DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The PWA factor is \$.27 per 1,000 gallons;

Section 3. All tiers of water usage and the wholesale water rate set forth in Larue County Water District No. 1's existing tariff shall be increased by \$.27 per 1,000 gallons, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC.

Section 4. The monthly water rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of the water system of Larue County Water District No.1 shall be as set forth in **Appendix A**, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution. The rates set forth in **Appendix A** are subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC. These monthly

rates shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after September 27, 2019 upon PSC approval.

Section 5. The Chairman and the General Manager are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the PWA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all other documents that may be required by the PSC.

Section 6. The Chairman, General Manager, and all appropriate Larue County Water District No. 1 Staff are hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the PWA.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
