Update on the progress of the Water Loss Control Program:

- 1. Hydro-Excavator has been purchased and is being used daily.
- 2. A full-time leak locator is on staff and doing leak detection daily.
- 3. We have chosen Honeywell Mag Meters for the DMA's
- 4. We currently have 23 metered DMA sites established and plan on at least 20 more.
- 5. See above
- 6. We are looking at the best technology for the prv monitoring.
- 7. The AMI meters are working pulling info. Daily from the DMA meters.
- 8. We are watching daily the DMA sites and this detremines the area that the leak specialists goes to each day.
- 9. The software for this is extremely expensive and we are looking at alternatives to the one vendor that has this predictive analysis software.
- 10.We still plan to have this system established and in check by 12/1/26.

As an item for information there is a fiber project in our area that will take two years with at least 10 crews working. The locates from this is taking a tremendous amount of time and money and is slowing the progress of the project significantly.
