

5	exposure for Big Rivers and Meade County RECC.

4	It is worth noting that Meade County RECC and the other Big Rivers Member-
5	Owners are in a much better position with the Nucor agreement than without it. The
6	Nucor contract was a significant achievement in the Load Mitigation Plan that
7	eliminated the need for a projected $8-12\%$ rate increase in the next few years. The
8	Nucor agreement was also the first step in the solar contracting process, which will
9	diversify the Big Rivers generation portfolio while bringing below-market energy to
10	our Member-Owners.

1	Item 3) If, for instance, in the event a \$15 per ton price on carbon
2	emissions was placed on BREC's generation units, explain how that would
3	affect the economics of the Nucor Retail Electric Service Agreement with
4	Nucor in each of the contract phases.
5	
6	Response) A \$15 per ton price of carbon placed on Big Rivers' generation units
7	should not impact the economics of the Nucor Retail Electric Service Agreement. It
8	is the intention of Big Rivers to hedge its price exposure during the first ten years of
9	the agreement, as described in Big Rivers' response to Item 2 of the Commission
10	Staff's Initial Request for Information and Item 1 of the Commission Staff's Second
11	Request for Information. Once those hedges are in place, the economics of the Nucor
12	transaction will be protected from any market price increases.
13	A per ton tax on carbon emissions will have no effect on the second ten years
14	of the Nucor agreement either.
