NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the City of Central City proposes to increase its rate for wholesale water service to Muhlenberg County Water District and Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3 effective July 31, 2019. On or about June 24, 2019, documentation will be filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission to increase rates as follows:

The proposed effective date is July 31, 2019. Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged at the current rate while water flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date will be charged at the proposed new rate.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the City of Central City, and are based on a requirement by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, acting through Rural Development ("RD") in connection with a loan by RD to the District in the principal amount of \$1,000,000, which includes \$150,000 of grant funding that RD has agreed to provide if the City meets certain conditions of RD, including revising the water rates as set forth above. The proposed rates are required under the terms of an agreement between the City and RD. The Public Service Commission has previously explained that if the Commission should find that a City must charge rates less than those specified by Rural Development, the City would fail to meet the conditions imposed by Rural Development. It further declined "to impair or impede" a City's ability to receive funding and that the General Assembly's policy expressed in KRS 278.023 supported its decision.

Comments regarding the filing may be submitted to the PSC through its website or by mail to Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602.

A timely written request for intervention that establishes grounds for the request may also be submitted to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602. If the PSC does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the date notice was initially provided, the PSC may take final action on the filing.

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-09-01

RESOLUTION A OF **MUHLENBERG** COUNTY WATER DISTRICT #3 **ADJUSTING ITS WATER** RATES TO OFFSET THE CENTRAL CITY MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM'S WHOLESALE RATE INCREASE

WHEREAS, the Central City Municipal and Sewer System ("Central City") supplies potable water to Muhlenberg County Water District #3("District") on a wholesale basis;

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2019, Central City filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") seeking to increase the wholesale water rate that Central City charges the District from \$2.63 to \$3.31 per 1,000 gallons (See PSC Case No. 2019-00260);

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the PSC will soon issue an Order approving Central City's proposed wholesale rate of \$3.31, and that the new wholesale rate will become effective on or about October 31, 2019.

WHEREAS, based upon the water purchases from Central City during the previous 12 months, the estimated annual increased cost to the District will be \$<u>145,513.13;</u>

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that the District take immediate action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with Central City's wholesale rate increase; and

WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068 provide the legal mechanism for the District to increase its water rates commensurate with Central City's wholesale rate increase via a Purchased Water Adjustment ("PWA");

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MUHLENBERG COUNTY WATER DISTRICT #3 DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The PWA factor is <u>\$.88</u> per 1,000 gallons;

Section 3. All tiers of water usage and the wholesale water rate set forth in the District's existing tariff shall be increased by $\underline{\$.88}$ per 1,000 gallons, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC.

Section 4. The monthly water rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of the water system of the District shall be as set forth in **Exhibit F**, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a

part of this Resolution. The rates set forth in **Exhibit F** are subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC. These monthly rates shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after the effective date of Central City's wholesale rate increase as determined by the PSC in Case No. 2019-00260.

Section 5. The Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the PWA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all other documents that may be required by the PSC.

Section 6. The Chairman, Superintendent, and all appropriate District Staff are hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the PWA.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
