Comes now the Harrison County Water Association, Inc., by and through their counsel, Mr. Jesse P. Melcher, Esq. and files the proof of advertising an notice as to its approved pass through rate adjustment pursuant to K.R.S. 278 and 807 KAR 5:068.


The Harrison County Water Association in November published notification of its application and request for a pass through rate adjustment of 0.37 cents per 1000 gallons. Subsequently, the Kentucky Public Service Commission denied the 0.37 cents per 1000 gallons and approved a pass through rate of 0.31 cents per 1000 gallons.

The Harrison County Water Association advertised the approved pass through rates prior the Bills being mailed out on or about January 3, 2020.

Copies of those news publications, with publisher verification will be supplemented to the file; a copy of the notice is attached hereto and identified, See. Exhibits, being and fully incorporated herein, as if written word for word herein.

A copy of the same Notice was placed on the door of the office as of November 7, 2019 with requested pass through rate and on December 12, 2019 of the approved pass through rate.

NOTICE OF KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

APPROVAL OF RATE INCREASE REQUEST

All customers of the Harrison County Water Association, Inc., which serves all of Harrison County, parts of: Scott County, Bourbon County, Pendleton County, and Nicholas County, Kentucky, PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING: The Harrison County Water Association, Inc., only distributes water it purchases, wherein, the primary provider of distributed water is the City of Cynthiana, Kentucky. The City of Cynthiana as of July 1, 2019, raised its rates of sold water to the Harrison County Water Association, Inc., by \$0.30 (i.e. thirty cents) per one thousand (\$1,000.00) gallons sold. The previous charged rate per 1,000 gallons purchased was \$2.85 and is now \$3.15 per one thousand (1,000) gallons purchased.

Therefore, pursuant to resolution and approved motion for a rate pass through adjustment for the Harrison County Water Association, Inc. to pass this rate increase along to its customers; all pursuant to KRS 278 & 807 KAR 5:068; The Harrison County Water Association, Inc. will begin charging **\$0.31** per 1,000.00 gallons purchased and/or used for each of its customers. This rate for each additional 1,000 gallons purchased and/or used shall be as follows (The current rate is reflected in the chart with the new proposed rate)

The Kentucky Public Service Commission approved the pass through rates on December 11, 2019.

The total pass through rate adjustment equates to thirty one cents (\$0.31) per one thousand gallons sold.

The average usage bill for the period of September 2018 to August 2019, consumed 4,444 gallons per month with an average bill of \$39.92. The proposed rate increase on the same average usage would \$1.55 to \$41.47; a 0.0388276 percent average increase change. 807 KAR 5:068, Section 5, (4)(d)

This rate increase will begin for the November 15 to December 15, 2019 meter reading period, which will be billed in the period of January 1-5, 2020

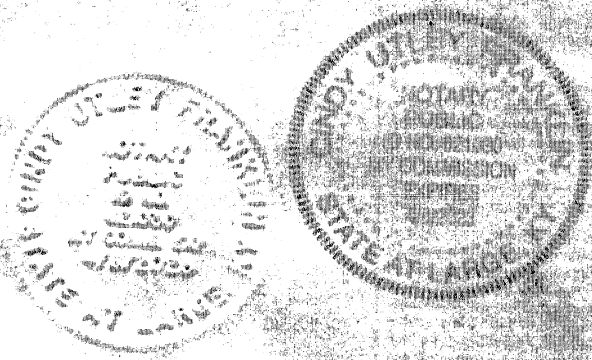
