MOTION TO EXCUSE THE ATTENDANCE OF WITNESS WILLIAM J. WOOTON AT THE SCHEDULED HEARING

Hyden-Leslie County Water District ("Hyden-Leslie District") moves the Public Service Commission for an order excusing William J. Wooton from appearing at the hearing scheduled for February 5, 2020. In support of its motion, Hyden-Leslie District states:

- 1. Mr. Wooton is a member of the Hyden-Leslie County Water District Board of Commissioners.
- 2. On January 17, 2020, the Public Service Commission issued an Order in which it directed Mr. Wooton to appear at the hearing scheduled in this matter.
- 3. On January 28, 2020, Commission Staff obtained a subpoena for Mr. Wooton to appear and testify as a witness at the scheduled hearing. Mr. Wooton was served with this subpoena on January 30, 2020.
- 4. Mr. Wooton is 85 years old and has suffered two heart attacks. As a result of the most recent heart attack, which occurred in 2016, he was hospitalization for three months at University of Kentucky Hospital. He is still undergoing physical therapy as a result of his second

heart attack and is administered medication for his heart. Mr. Wooton also suffers from chronic

obstructive pulmonary disease and high blood pressure. Mr. Wooten's physician has informed

him that the lengthy travel from Hyden, Kentucky to Frankfort is unadvisable and may be

detrimental to his health. A statement from Mr. Wooten's physician is attached.

5. Mr. Wooten is one of five members of Hyden-Leslie County Water District Board

of Commissioners directed to appear at the scheduled hearing and to whom Commission Staff

has issued a subpoena to testify before the Public Service Commission. His testimony is likely

to duplicate that of the other Board members. His absence should not lessen or restrict the Public

Service Commission's ability to conduct its inquiry into the Board's actions.

6. If the Public Service Commission finds that Mr. Wooten's testimony is necessary

to its inquiry, Hyden-Leslie District respectfully requests that alternative means of taking that

testimony be considered that would allow Mr. Wooten to respond to questions without having to

travel to the Public Service Commission's offices in Frankfort.

WHEREFORE, Hyden-Leslie County Water District requests that Mr. William J.

Wooten be excused from appearing at the scheduled hearing in this matter and that subpoena

requiring his appearance be withdrawn
