RESPONSE OF CALDWELL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AND LYON COUNTY WATER DISTRICT TO PRINCETON WATER AND WASTEWATER COMMISSION’S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE DATA REQUESTS AFTER DEADLINE

Come now Caldwell County Water District (“Caldwell County”) and Lyon County Water District (“Lyon County”), by and through the undersigned counsel and for their response to Princeton Water and Wastewater Commission’s (“Princeton”) Motion for Leave to File Data Requests After Deadline states as follows:

1. In the Commission’s February 21, 2020 Scheduling Order the deadline to serve data requests on Intervenors was set at Friday, April 3, 2020.
2. Princeton emailed counsel for Caldwell County and Lyon County copies of data requests it intended to serve them on Sunday, April 5, 2020 and nearly simultaneously submitted them electronically to the Commission as well.
3. Caldwell County and Lyon County do not object to Princeton’s data requests being filed after the filing deadline.
4. Due to the current state of emergency for COVID-19, communications with personnel essential to providing information for completion of these data requests, who are now working


remotely and with limited access to business information, has become significantly more complicated and time-consuming.

5. Caldwell County and Lyon County request an extension to respond to Princeton's untimely-filed data requests until Friday, April 24, 2020. Princeton has indicated to counsel that it does not object to the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, Caldwell County and Lyon County do not object to Princeton's Motion to File Data Requests After Deadline and Caldwell County and Lyon County request an extension to respond to Princeton's Data Requests until Friday, April 24, 2020.
