Re: Letter of Conditions Dated December 5, 2017

Dear Chairman Barton:

This letter shall serve as Amendment No. 1 to the Letter of Conditions dated December 5, 2017. The purpose of this amendment is to revise the rates and charges and make other editorial changes in accordance with current Rural Utilities Service (RUS) instructions.

Paragraph numbered "33" is revised to read as follows:

"33. Rates and Charges:

Rates and charges for facilities and services rendered by the District must be at least adequate to meet cost of maintaining, repairing and operating the water system and meeting required principal and interest payments and the required deposits to debt service and/or depreciation reserve.

Water rates will be at least:

Wholesale Rate will be \$2.14 per 1,000 gallons.

All other provisions of the referenced Letter of Conditions remain in full force and unchanged.
