("EKPC"), by and through counsel, pursuant to the February 11, 2020 Order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") in the above-styled case and other applicable law, and does hereby move to submit the case for adjudication based upon the existing administrative record and without the need for a public hearing, respectfully stating as follows:

The Commission initiated this case on February 11, 2020 to examine the application of EKPC's Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC") during the six-month period commencing on May 1, 2019 and concluding on October 31, 2019. The Commission propounded initial data requests at the same time it issued its February 11, 2020 Order. EKPC provided responses to the Commission's data requests on February 25, 2020. No supplemental information requests have been received, nor has any other person sought intervention in the case. The Commission's February 11, 2020 Order affords EKPC until April 3, 2020 to request a formal hearing. At this point, EKPC does not believe that a formal hearing is necessary and, in the interest of

administrative economy, respectfully requests the Commission to adjudicate the case on the existing administrative record and without the need for a public hearing.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, EKPC respectfully requests the Commission to adjudicate the case on the existing administrative record and without the need for a public hearing.
