## MOTION TO SUBMIT CASE FOR ADJUDICATION ON THE ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD

Comes now Salt River Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Salt River Electric"), by counsel, and hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to submit the case for a decision based upon the existing record and without the need for a hearing, respectfully stating as follows:

On February 11, 2020, the Commission issued an Order opening an investigation for the six-month review of Salt River Electric's application of the Fuel Adjustment Clause from May 1, 2019 through October 31, 2019. The February 11, 2020 Order contained a procedural schedule that allowed for the filing of an affidavit of compliance and a deadline for motions to intervene in the case. There have been no motions for intervention filed in this case. Salt River Electric has until April 3, 2020, to request a hearing or state that the case should be submitted on the record.

Since there are no intervenors in this case, Salt River Electric believes the administrative record is complete and it would be appropriate for the Commission to make a ruling based upon the record. Salt River Electric respectfully requests a decision from the Commission based upon the existing record.
