**MOTION TO SUBMIT CASE FOR ADJUDICATION
ON THE ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD**

Comes now Fleming-Mason Energy Cooperative, Inc. (“Fleming-Mason Energy”), by counsel, and hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to submit the case for a decision based upon the existing record and without the need for a hearing, respectfully stating as follows:

On February 11, 2020, the Commission issued an Order opening an investigation for the six-month review of Fleming-Mason Energy’s application of the Fuel Adjustment Clause from May 1, 2019 through October 31, 2019. The February 11, 2020 Order contained a procedural schedule that allowed for the filing of an affidavit of compliance and a deadline for motions to intervene in the case. There have been no motions for intervention filed in this case. Fleming-Mason Energy has until April 3, 2020, to request a hearing or state that the case should be submitted on the record.

Since there are no intervenors in this case, Fleming-Mason Energy believes the administrative record is complete and it would be appropriate for the Commission to make a ruling

based upon the record. Fleming-Mason Energy respectfully requests a decision from the Commission based upon the existing record.

WHEREFORE, Fleming-Mason Energy moves the Commission to submit the case on the existing administrative record.
