MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Grayson") hereby moves the Commission for an order granting it an extension of fourteen days, through March 12, 2021 to file its comments to the Liberty Audit Report and to file its action plan in response to the audit. As grounds for this motion, Grayson states that its plant and service area have suffered from a widespread and catastrophic snow and ice storm that began on February 10, 2021. At one point, over seventy percent of Grayson's members were without power. As of the morning of February 23, 2021, approximately 3,800 members remain without power and there are 204 broken electric poles. Grayson has been devoting all its time and resources to restoring power to its members as quickly and safely as possible and those considerable efforts have prevented it from being able to devote sufficient time and resources to competing its action plans and comments with respect to the Liberty Audit Report.

Wherefore, Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation respectfully prays for the appropriate order granting the requested extension of time.
