

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

### NOTICE

On January 22, 2020, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Farmdale Water District's (Farmdale District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$153,145, approximately a 13.50 percent increase. After performing a review of Farmdale District's application and records, the PSC Staff recommended that Farmdale District be granted an increase in water service revenues of approximately 15.45 percent. Pursuant to the PSC's Order of February 10, 2020, in Case No. 2020-00021, Farmdale District requested that the PSC approve the PSC Staff-recommended revenue requirement and that Farmdale District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:
