MOTION FOR DEVIATION FROM 807 KAR 5:001, SECTION 4(10)

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 21, Green River Valley Water District ("Green River Valley District") moves for a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10) to permit it to file its responses to the Commission Staff's First Request for Information without redacting certain personal information. In support of its Motion, Green River Valley District states:

1. On February 20, 2020, Commission Staff issued its First Request for Information to Green River Valley District.

2. Item No. 1 of that Request sought a copy of all written complaints related to low water pressure. Item No. 2 of that Request sought the name, address and other pertinent information of customers who had individual pumps installed to their water services. Item No. 9 requests the name and address of each customer whose water service pressure is less than 30 pounds per square inch.

3. In its responses filed on March 23, 2020, Green River Valley District submitted a copy of each work order addressing a complaint regarding low water pressure. Each work order contains the name, address, telephone and account number of the complaining customer. It also provided the names and addresses of customers requested by Items No. 2 and No. 9.

3. 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10) provides: "If a person files a paper containing personal information, the person shall encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read." "Personal information" includes an individual's first name or first initial and last name in combination with "[t]he address, phone number, or email address of an individual who is not a party and has not requested to be a party." 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10)(a)(7).

4. To the best of Green River Valley District's knowledge and good faith belief, the information contained in the Response is necessary to assist the Commission in its review of the proposed tariff and redaction of the information would frustrate the purpose for which the information was requested.

5. This unredacted information will not allow any person to access the customer's water account or to take any action regarding that account nor will it enable any person access to any financial account.

WHEREFORE, Green River Valley District requests that the Commission grant a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10) and accept Green River Valley District's Response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information in its current form.
