Kentucky Power Company’s Motion to Amend Rehearing Procedural Schedule

Kentucky Power Company moves the Commission to amend the procedural schedule established by the Commission’s February 3, 2021 Order in this case. The Company requests that the date for the Company to either request a hearing or that the case be submitted for decision on the record be extended fourteen days from March 26, 2021 to April 9, 2021.

Kentucky Power states that on March 23, 2021 it received Commission Staff’s Second Request for Information on Rehearing. The responses to those requests are due April 2, 2021. Because the original date by which the Company must request a hearing or to submit the case on the record is March 26, 2021, the Company would have to address the need for a hearing prior to being able to answer Staff’s second set of rehearing data requests. The Company requests a fourteen-day extension so that it may fully evaluate the complete record of the case, including the Company’s forthcoming responses to Staff’s second set of rehearing data requests, prior to determining whether the matter should be submitted on the record or instead requires a hearing.

This motion is being made as soon as was practicable after receiving Staff’s second set of rehearing data requests. This motion further is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power Company requests that the Commission issue an Order:

- (a) Amending its February 3, 2021 rehearing procedural schedule in this case to permit the Company to request a hearing or that the case be submitted for decision on the record on or before April 9, 2021; and
- (b) Granting Kentucky Power such other relief as may be appropriate.
