Kentucky Power Company's Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule

Kentucky Power Company moves the Commission to amend a single aspect of the procedural schedule established by the Commission's September 24, 2020 Order in this case. The Company requests that the date for the Company to file responses to supplemental requests for information be extended nine days from November 23, 2020 to December 2, 2020. The Company is not requesting modification of any other dates in the September 24, 2020 Order.

Kentucky Power states that date currently scheduled for the Company's responses to supplemental requests for information, November 23, 2020, falls at the end of or immediately after the hearing in Case No. 2020-00174. That hearing is scheduled to begin November 17, 2020 and will continue through at least November 20, 2020. The Company anticipates that some of the persons responsible for preparing and reviewing the supplemental data requests in this proceeding will be involved in, or supporting the Company's witnesses in, the hearing in Case No. 2020-00174.

A hearing has not yet been scheduled in this proceeding, and thus the proposed extension would not require a continuance of any hearing. Further if the requested extension is granted, the


Company offers to waive or extend the 120-day requirement within which the Commission must act on this matter from January 4, 2021 to February 1, 2021.

This motion is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power Company requests that the Commission issue an Order:

- (a) Amending its September 24, 2020 procedural schedule in this case to permit the Company to file its responses to supplemental requests for information on or before December 2, 2020; and
- (b) Granting Kentucky Power such other relief as may be appropriate.
