JOINT MOTION FOR TELEPHONIC INFORMAL CONFERENCE

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(4), Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) (collectively, “the Companies”) move for the scheduling of a telephonic informal conference in the above-referenced proceedings if the Commission believes it would be beneficial.

In support of its Motion, the Companies state:

1. Given the limited time for review and the uncertainties resulting from the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Companies offer to participate in a telephonic informal conference if the Commission believes a telephonic informal conference will assist in the efficient presentation and discussion of the issues presented by the Companies’ Applications.

2. If a telephonic informal conference is held, the Companies will provide an overview of the Applications, the requests contained in the Applications, and the reasons for such requests. KU and LG&E representatives will be available to answer the questions of Commission Staff and any intervening party regarding the requests and any other aspect of the Applications.

3. If the Commission agrees that a telephonic informal conference would be beneficial, the Companies request that this telephonic informal conference be scheduled some time

during the next 2-3 weeks after the Commission has had the opportunity to review the Companies' Applications.

WHEREFORE, KU and LG&E move that the Commission schedule a telephonic informal conference in this matter for the purpose of reviewing the Companies' Applications at the Commission's convenience.
