A filing deficiency was issued by the PSC on April 23, 2020. The filing was rejected for a deficiency pursuant to 807 KAR 5:01, Section 18(2)(c). It proceeds to state that if the property is to be acquired, detailed estimates by USOA must be provided.

It is submitted that the Elkhorn Water District is attempting to obtain a lease of the subject property. Therefore, the provisions of 807 KAR 5:01, Section 18(2)(c) should not apply. In the event the Elkhorn Water District changes its plans and will attempt to acquire a fee simple interest in the subject property, then the application will be amended to reflect same.
