



On or about May 7, 2020, Hyden-Leslie County Water District will file an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its monthly rates for water service and certain nonrecurring charges. This application will be filed pursuant to the procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:076. Under those procedures, the proposed rates may not be placed into effect until the Kentucky Public Service Commission has issued an order approving the proposed rates or six (6) months from the date of the filing of the application, whichever occurs first. Hyden-Leslie County Water District has not adjusted its monthly rates for water service since October 2010 nor its nonrecurring charges since May 1992.

Hyden-Leslie County Water District proposes to adjust its rates for monthly water service in two phases. Phase I rates will become effective upon the Kentucky Public Service Commission’s approval. Phase II rates will become effective one year later. The proposed rates are as follows:

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, the Phase I monthly bill for an average residential customer who uses 4,000 gallons per month will increase from \$31.48 to \$44.75, or 42.2 percent. The Phase I monthly bill for a commercial customer using an average of 10,000 gallons per month will increase from \$89.05 to \$126.54, or 42.1 percent. The Phase II monthly bill for a residential customer using an average of 4,000 gallons per month will increase from \$44.75 to \$53.59, or 19.8 percent. The Phase II monthly bill for a commercial customer using an average of 10,000 gallons per month will increase from \$126.54 to \$151.57, or 19.8 percent.
