**Kentucky Power Company's Motion
For Confidential Treatment**

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or “Company”) moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“Commission”) pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(2), and KRS 61.878(1) for an Order granting confidential treatment to the stenographic transcripts of the November 17, 2020, November 19, 2020, and November 23, 2020 confidential sessions of the hearing in this matter. The confidential sessions were duly convened by the Chairman in response to proposed questioning regarding materials previously granted confidential treatment in this matter by the orders of the Commission, or materials that were the subject of pending motions for confidential treatment. The corresponding motions and Commission orders are incorporated by reference and further serve as the basis of this motion.

The stenographic transcripts of the November 17, 2020, November 19, 2020, and November 23, 2020 public sessions of the hearing are being filed separately in the public record; the transcripts that are the subject of this motion are confidential in their entirety.

The transcripts should be accorded confidential treatment for the periods for which the underlying materials were granted confidential treatment. Kentucky Power will notify the

Commission if the Company determines prior to the end of the period for which confidential treatment is sought that the stenographic transcripts are no longer confidential.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests the Commission to enter an Order:

1. According confidential status to the stenographic transcripts of the November 17, 2020, November 19, 2020, and November 23, 2020 confidential sessions of the hearing in this matter for the periods for which the underlying materials were granted confidential treatment; and
2. Granting Kentucky Power all further relief to which it may be entitled.
