

**Kentucky Power Company's Report Regarding Refunds
In Conformity With The Commission's May 14, 2021 Order**

Kentucky Power Company files this report in response to the Commission's May 14, 2021 Order directing the Company to file "its proposed plan for refunding all amounts collected in excess of the Tariff NMS II rates approved in ... [the May 14, 2021 Order].

1. No customers took service under Tariff NMS II.
2. Two applicants for service were charged the higher application fees proposed by the Company that were disallowed by the Commission. The Company will make the required refunds to the two customers by means of a credit to the two affected customers' bills within 30 days of this filing.
