**Kentucky Power Company's Motion For
The Preparation Of A Stenographic Transcription**

Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power" or "Company") moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky ("Commission") pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9)(a)(1) and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9)(a)(2) for an Order providing for a stenographic transcript of the hearing beginning November 17, 2020 in this proceeding to be prepared by a Commission-authorized court reporter. The Company understands that pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9)(a)(3), it will be responsible for the cost of the transcript and having the transcript filed in the record within a reasonable time after the completion of the hearing.

The transcription will aid the parties in the briefing of this matter and may aid the Commission in its deliberations. The Company requests that the stenographic transcription be made with the court reporter present in the hearing room and not from the digital recording.

If the Company's motion is granted, Kentucky Power will retain the services of McLendon-Kogut Reporting Service, LLC. The individuals expected to provide the reporting services are:


- (1) Laura J. Kogut;
