Bowling Green Municipal Utilities, our wastewater treatment provider, is increasing our wholesale sewage treatment rate effective July 1, 2020. Warren County Water District intends to pass this increase through to our retail customers in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068. In addition, we are requesting that the proposed rate increase to our customers be effective July 1, 2020.
