**ATTORNEY GENERAL’S NOTICE AND MOTION TO AMEND  
THE JULY 28, 2020 PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The intervenor, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky by and through his Office of Rate Intervention (“Attorney General”), hereby provides notice that after reviewing Big Rivers Electric Corporation’s (“BREC”) responses to the Attorney General’s First Request for Information, no intervenor testimony will be submitted on August 24, 2020, as allowed by the July 28, 2020 amended truncated procedural schedule. This will open up at least three additional weeks in the procedural schedule due to no intervenor testimony being filed in the pending case. Thus, the Attorney General respectfully requests to amend the July 28, 2020 procedural schedule to provide additional time to serve a Second Request for Information to BREC, in order to obtain clarification of certain responses to the Attorney General’s First Request for Information.

WHEREFORE, the Attorney General provides notice that he does not intend to file Intervenor testimony in the present case, and as such, respectfully requests an amendment to the July 28, 2020 procedural schedule allowing a Second Request for Information to BREC.
