MOTION TO DISMISS WITHOUT PREJUDICE

Comes South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("South Kentucky"), by counsel, and moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an order dismissing this case, without prejudice, from the Commission's docket. In support of its motion South Kentucky states as follows:

- 1. On or about August 18, 2020, South Kentucky filed a Motion to Hold Case in Abeyance alerting the Commission to newly discovered information regarding The People Fund, Inc.'s corporate and tax-exempt statuses. In that filing South Kentucky advised the Commission that it was uncertain when all state and federal corporate and tax-status reinstatement approvals would be received, but estimated that it would likely take between 90-180 days.¹
- 2. Considering the uncertainty of the current COVID-19 situation and associated administrative delays, South Kentucky believes it would be prudent for the Commission to dismiss this case, without prejudice, to allow receipt of all necessary state and federal approvals. Once such approvals are received, South Kentucky will re-file its tariff change request.
