# **ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORT**

Farmdale Water District

Case No. 2020-00217

**Reporting Period:** July 2021 through June 2022

**Estimated and Actual Progress of Water Loss Detection and Repair Program:**

Farmdale Water District has not yet completed its Water Loss Detection and Repair Program because its comprehensive water audit report and Qualified Infrastructure Improvement Plan have not been completed. Farmdale Water District has filed a Motion for Extension of Time until February 22, 2023 in Case No. 2020-00217 in which to complete and file its Qualified Infrastructure Plan. The results of the comprehensive water audit report will greatly influence the system improvements and priorities to be included in the Qualified Infrastructure Improvement Plan, which will result in a complete and robust Water Loss Detection and Repair Program.

**Estimated and Actual Expenditures Made with Surcharge Proceeds:**

Farmdale Water District has complied with the Commission's requirements to file a monthly surcharge activity report and a monthly water loss report. These reports have been filed in the case record in Case No. 2020-00217. According to the last surcharge activity report filed on December 14, 2022, the balance in the FWD Water Loss Surcharge account as of November 30, 2022 is \$197,291.34. Farmdale Water District has **not** spent any of this money.
