## Farmdale Water District Statement of Completion August 21, 2025

### METER TESTING OR REPLACEMENT PURSUANT TO 807 KAR 5:066, SECTION 16(1)

In its final Order in Case No. 2022-00347 the Commission ordered Farmdale District to replace all meters in its system that were out of compliance with the meter-testing regulation or to test the meters before August 31, 2025. Farmdale District completed the required meter replacement late in the evening on Wednesday, **August 13, 2025**. In total, Farmdale District replaced **1,410** meters. Farmdale District's records now indicate there are no meters in its system that are out of compliance with the meter-testing regulations.
