RESOLUTION NO. 2020-07-14

A RESOLUTION OF CALDWELL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ADJUSTING ITS WATER RATES TO OFFSET THE CITY OF PRINCETONS' AND SOUTH HOPKINS WATER DISTRICTS' WHOLESALE RATE INCREASE

WHEREAS, the City of Princeton and South Hopkins Water District supplies potable water to Caldwell County Water District on a wholesale basis'

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2020 the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") approved an increase from the City of Princeton see Case No. 2019-00444 and on July 12, 2019 the PSC approved an increase from South Hopkins Water District see Case No. 2019-00204.

WHEREAS, based upon the water purchases from the City of Princeton and South Hopkins Water District during the previous 12 months, the estimated annual increased cost to Caldwell County Water District will be \$ 30,366;

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that Caldwell County Water District take action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with the City of Princeton's and South Hopkins Water District's wholesale rate increase; and

WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068 provide the legal

mechanism for Caldwell County Water District to increase its water rates to commensurate with the City of Princeton's and South Hopkins Water

District's wholesale rate increase via a Purchased Water Adjustment ("PWA")

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF Caldwell County Water District DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The PWA factor is \$.38 per 1,000 gallons;

Section 3. All tiers of water usage and the wholesale water rate set forth in Caldwell County Water District's existing tariff shall be increased by \$.38 per 1,000 gallons, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC.

Section 4. The monthly water rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of the water system of Caldwell County Water District shall be as set forth in Exhibit C, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution. The rates set forth in Exhibit C are subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC. These monthly rates shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after July 29, 2020 upon PSC approval.

Section 5. The Chairperson and the CEO are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the PWA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all other documents that may be required by the PSC.

Section 6. The Chairman, CEO, and all appropriate Caldwell County Staff are hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the PWA.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
