APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 2020-00238 DATED DEC 17 2020 NOTICE TO THE CUSTOMERS OF NORTH MCLEAN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

On August 4, 2020, North Mclean County Water District (North Mclean District) applied to the Centucky Public Service Commission (PSC) for authority to adjust its rates for water service. The nitial proposed effective date of the requested rate adjustment was made pursuant to the date of an Order granting an increase by the PSC. After performing a limited review of North Mclean District's application and records, the PSG Staff has recommended to the PSC that North Mclean adjust its rates to their retail customers that are different from those proposed by North Mclean The tables below reflect the present retail rates and the retail rates propased by the PSC Staff.
