Notice to the Record

In ¶19 of its Application for Certificates of Construction filed December 8, 2020, Unbridled Solar, LLC stated that the applicable setback requirement for the Webster County portions of its proposed generating facility was the 2000-foot setback in KRS 278.706(2)(e) and that there are “two clusters of residences ... that arguably could meet the KRS 278.700(6) definition of a “residential neighborhood” and for which some generation facilities or structures in the Webster County portion of the Project are within 2000 feet of the residences’ area.” In an abundance of caution, Unbridled anticipated that it “will file a separate request for any deviation needed from the 2000-foot setback requirement as to those clusters of residences.” (*Id.*)

On further review, it has become evident that no deviation is needed from the statutory setback requirement as to those two clusters or any other residence clusters. In this rural area, there are no residential neighborhoods as close or closer than 2000 feet of any of proposed generating facilities or structures in Webster County. PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Unbridled Solar, LLC will not be filing the “separate request for any deviation needed from the 2000-foot setback requirement” anticipated in Application ¶19.
