On July 28, 2020, Caldwell Solar, LLC ("Caldwell") submitted for filing its Notice of Intent to file and was assigned Case No. 2020-00244. Now, Caldwell submits this Renewed Notice of Intent to file an application for a construction certificate for a 200 MW merchant solar generating facility in Caldwell County, Kentucky.

b. A brief description of the proposed construction:

Caldwell is proposing an up to 200 MW merchant solar generating facility consisting of solar photovoltaic arrays and associated racking, inverters, and a project substation located on approximately 2,000 acres in Caldwell County. For interconnection, Caldwell will connect to the Caldwell County to Barkley 161 kV transmission line of Big Rivers Electric Corporation.

- c. No street address has been established at this time for Caldwell; however, Caldwell proposes to locate in Caldwell County, approximately 3 miles southeast of Fredonia, Kentucky at a latitude and longitude of 37.157445° N and 88.004156° W. Caldwell's proposed generating facility will not be located within the boundaries of any city.
- d. Caldwell County does not have a planning and zoning commission with jurisdiction over the site.
- e. No zoning ordinances apply for the reason articulated in (d).
- f. Pursuant to KRS 278.704(4), the applicant will request any deviation necessary from the setback requirements found in KRS 278.704(2).
