To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to KRS 278.700, *et seq.*, and 807 KAR 5:110, Caldwell Solar, LLC (“Caldwell”) hereby submits this Notice of Intent to file an application for a construction certificate for a 200 MW merchant solar generating facility in Caldwell County, Kentucky.

- b. A brief description of the proposed construction:

Caldwell is proposing an up to 200 MW merchant solar generating facility consisting of solar photovoltaic arrays and associated racking, inverters, and a project substation located on approximately 2,000 acres in Caldwell County. For interconnection, Caldwell will connect to the Caldwell County to Barkley 161 kV transmission line of Big Rivers Electric Corporation.

- c. Caldwell proposes to locate in Caldwell County, approximately 3 miles southeast of Fredonia, Kentucky at a latitude and longitude of 37.157445° N and 88.004156° W.

- Caldwell's proposed generating facility will not be located within the boundaries of any city.
- d. Caldwell County does not have a planning and zoning commission with jurisdiction over the site.
 - e. No zoning ordinances apply for the reason articulated in (d).
 - f. Pursuant to KRS 278.704(4), the applicant will request a deviation from the setback requirements found in KRS 278.704(2).
