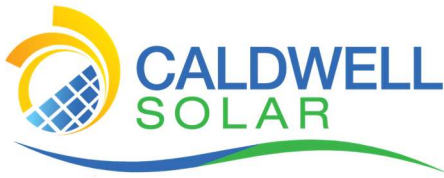

About the Caldwell Solar Project

The Caldwell Solar Project (Caldwell Solar or Project) is an up to 200 MW solar site under development on approximately 2,000 acres southeast of Fredonia in Caldwell County, KY. The Project will interconnect to the Caldwell County to Barkley 161 kV transmission line. The enclosed map identifies the proposed location and the project boundary. Permitting for the project will continue through 2020 with the goal of commercial operation in 2023.

Estimated Caldwell Solar Local Economic Impacts During First 20 Years of Operation:

- Direct Economic Impact Total Over \$20 Million+
- Tax Revenue: ~\$6.6 million (~\$265,000 annually)
- Jobs: ~7 full-time jobs (~\$490,000 annually)
- Education Fund: ~\$800,000 (~\$40,000 annually) - Unique donation for Geronimo Energy projects
