**ATTORNEY GENERAL’S AND ATMOS ENERGY CORPORATION’S
JOINT STATEMENT REGARDING SUBMISSION OF CASE**

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention (“Attorney General”), and Atmos Energy Corporation (“Atmos”) hereby submit their joint statement regarding submission of this case for a decision. Pursuant to the Commission’s October 19, 2020 Order in this matter, the parties are required by February 25, 2021, to either request a hearing or state whether the case can be submitted on the existing record. The Attorney General and Atmos agree that a hearing is not necessary and that the case should be submitted for a decision on the record after each party files a brief stating their respective positions. The Attorney General and Atmos further agree and respectfully request that they be permitted to file simultaneous briefs no later than February 25, 2021, and that the matter then be submitted for a decision without a hearing.
