

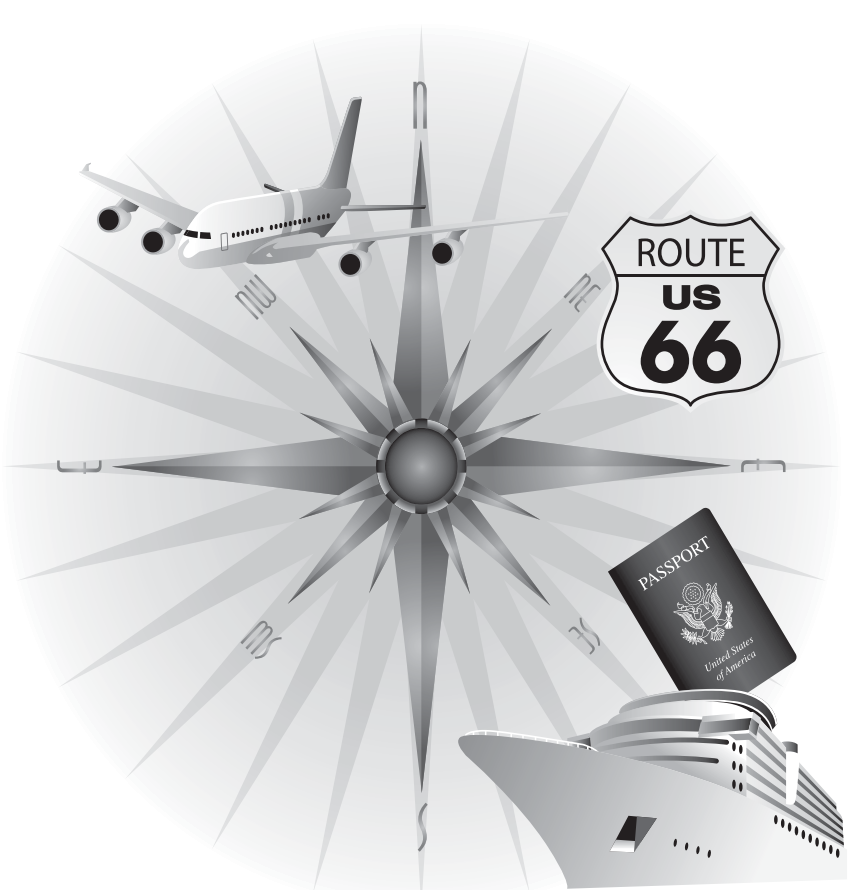

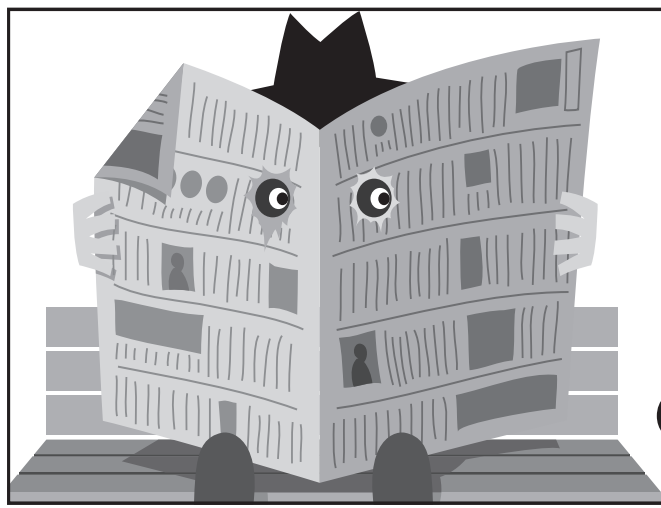

Scotty Pippen Jr., the SEC’s leading scorer, nearly matched his average with 17 points by halftime. He finished with 32. But junior Jordan Wright was held scoreless for the first time this season after averaging 12.7 points a game for Vanderbilt. Trey Thomas added 14 for the Commodores.

With 7-footer Liam Robbins sidelined by a foot issue, Vanderbilt strug-

gled to defend Tshiebwe. Coach Jerry Stackhouse called the 6-foot-9 Tshiebwe a “handful.”

“Hat’s off to him,” Stackhouse said. “He had a great game putting the ball in the basket, being really aggressive on the boards. It was his night.”

Vanderbilt never got closer than a tie at 22 after an 11-0 run early.

Kentucky answered Vandy’s run with 14 straight points, pushing the lead back to double digits. Stackhouse, now 1-7 against AP Top 25 teams, slammed a

clipboard during a timeout.

Tshiebwe scored five of the final seven points as Kentucky led 41-27 at halftime.

The Wildcats led by as much as 78-50 with 6:14 left. The only thing that kept Vandy from allowing a season high in points was finishing the game on a 16-0 run.

Enough Wildcats fans filled Memorial Gym that it felt a bit like Rupp Arena South, especially when they chanted “Go Big Blue” repeatedly.

Commodores fans

weren’t happy students weren’t allowed at this game with university officials limiting in-person activities until Jan. 24 amid a surge in COVID-19 cases. Plenty of Kentucky blue sprinkled the student section that had gold shakers at each seat waiting to be used.

“There’s a huge anointment and entitlement that can affect your program. So now it turns for us to ... what we’ve got to do to keep it going.”

Smart knows that he’ll have to replace a number of key players, especially on the defensive side.

Nose tackle Jordan Davis, linebacker Nakobe Dean and end Travon Walker all have a shot at going in the first round of the NFL draft. Tackle Devonte Wyatt, cornerback Derion Kendrick, and linebackers Chaning Tindall and Quay

Walker are expected to move on as well.

On the offensive side, running back James Cook and linemen Jamaire Salyer and Justin Shaffer have their sights on the pros. Receiver George Pickens missed much of the season with a knee injury, but he also could be headed to the NFL draft.

Smart has several players who plan to enter the transfer portal, though they held off on making their decisions public until after the national championship game.

Finally, Georgia is still putting the finishing touches on another stellar recruiting class.

“We don’t know how

many spots we have because we don’t know what some guys are doing,” Smart said. “There’s a lot of work to be done.”

The most intriguing position is quarterback.

Stetson Bennett, a former walk-on who took over the starting job after JT Daniels was injured, is a fifth-year senior but does have another year of eligibility because of COVID-19.

Daniels, a former top recruit who transferred to Georgia from Southern California after the 2019 season, also has an extra year of eligibility remaining. Further down the depth chart are Carson Beck and Brock Vandagriff, soon

to be joined by 2022 signee Gunner Stockton.

Hard to envision all of them being with the Bulldogs next season.

Bennett, the offensive MVP of both the Orange Bowl semifinal and the national championship game, isn’t regarded as a top NFL prospect, so he could come back for a sixth season.

Then again, what a way to go out if he decides to get on with his post-college life.

Bennett was tight-lipped about his future Tuesday morning.

“I don’t want to spill all my personal stuff out here on the table,” he said. “We’ll keep that between me and coach Smart.”

In the meantime, there’s a championship to savor.

The Bulldogs certainly earned it, knocking off college football’s greatest dynasty and the coach generally considered the best to ever walk the sideline.

“Bama is a world-class caliber team,” said safe-

ty Lewis Cine, the defensive MVP of the national championship game. “We knew that Bama has always been at the top. And to beat the team at the top is something really surreal.”

“It’s something that goes down in history and something that I’ll remember forever.”

Raiders have their coach after Bisaccia aces tryout

The firing in Miami was a head scratcher, considering Brian Flores won eight of his last nine games and seemed to have the Dolphins moving firmly in the right direction. Not so much in Minnesota and Chicago, where both the coaches and general managers had long since worn out their welcome.

Black Monday offered up the usual number of casualties across the NFL, where missing the playoffs means a pink slip might not be far behind. The season is over for 18 teams and there's no reason to waste time cleaning house. No reason to dally around looking for a new coach, either, though diversity interviews — and hopefully some diversity hires — will slow the process some. Except in Las Vegas, that is. There, all Raiders owner Mark Davis needs to do is one little thing — ignore shiny objects like Jim Harbaugh and drop the word interim from Rich Bisaccia's title.

Do it regardless of what happens in Cincinnati this weekend as the Raiders try to win their first playoff game in 19 years. Do it because it's the right thing to do for the players who believe in him the most.

Heck, do it because Sunday night's thriller against the Chargers to end the NFL's regular season answered any remaining questions about Bisaccia's coaching acumen.

The football lifer who had never led a team at any level has earned the right to be a head coach at football's highest level. After nearly two decades

coaching special teams in the NFL, he's an overnight success story no one saw coming. Think about it. When Bisaccia was first handed the reins of the team after Jon Gruden was sent packing, he had trouble figuring out how to use the headset on the sidelines.

Now he's got the Raiders in the playoffs — and they look like a team that's not ready to go away easily. The blue collar coach who spent 38 years in college and pros waiting for his chance found it unexpectedly when Gruden was run out of town because of his disturbing emails. In just 12 games, the 61-year-old has crafted the team in his own image, going 7-5 despite ongoing turmoil that included wide receiver Henry Ruggs III killing a woman while racing his car through city streets.

Players say they love him, and his unassuming personality is one big reason why. While Gruden had to be the center of attention on any team, Bisaccia came to the job with the ego of a longtime assistant who thought his time at the top would never come. His players play hard for him, the one intangible any coach needs in order to succeed. Every game. Every down. "I think we've tried to develop a group of men that care about each other, know what to do and compete with relentless effort," Bisaccia said. "And that's a hard team to beat."

It was Sunday night in a primetime game that closed out the NFL regular season in style. The Raiders blew a 15-point fourth-quarter lead only to

win on a last-second kick in overtime that had a full house at Allegiant Stadium screaming in glee. They would have advanced on a tie, too, but that's another story in itself. And there are plenty of stories to go around on a team that found a way to win its last four games to finish 10-7 and earn a spot against the Bengals in Cincinnati.

"Just to see how coach Bisaccia led us this year, our coaching staff staying together," quarterback Derek Carr said. "Hopefully it'd be a Disney movie someday, and I get to play coach Bisaccia." Those kind of movies only get made if Super Bowls are won, and no one yet is touting the Raiders to be in Los Angeles in February. Just winning one playoff game would be a building block, even if the Raiders are 6-point underdogs against the Bengals.

Still, Bisaccia has done the job he was asked to do — and more. He's been steady through a season of adversity, and he has his team playing hard and playing together just when they need it the most. He's treats his coordinators as co-equals, and they and the other assistants have bought in, too, just like the players. Along the way, he's also figured out a few things about what it takes to be the head man himself. "I'd like to think that I've improved," Bisaccia said. "I'd like to think that I've grown in a positive way."

He has, even if the tryout isn't quite over. The Raiders still have games — or a game — to play. Still, the argument can be made that Bisaccia has already

aced the audition. building four champions. There was no doubt the Giants played hard under Judge. They never gave up. They just didn't win enough, especially this season which was marked by at least a dozen season-ending injuries. The O-line lost two starters in the first two weeks of the season, and leading tackler and linebacker Blake Martinez went down early. Judge did seem to unite the Giants. There was little dissent. He repeatedly said he was changing the attitude and that would be a part of the process to build a winner. Now, the new general manager will hire another coach to try to turn the Giants around yet again. "This will be a comprehensive search for our next general manager," said Mara upon Gittleman's retirement. "We are looking for a person who demonstrates exceptional leadership and communication abilities, somebody who will oversee all aspects of our football operations, including player personnel, college scouting and coaching." The Giants have already put together a list of nine GM candidates they plan to interview, including long-time assistant general manager Kevin Abrams. He might be a hard sell for fans because he has been associated with the organization for more than two decades. The team has made the playoffs once (2016) since winning its fourth Super Bowl in February 2012. The others on the list are Bills assistant general manager Joe Schoen; Tennessee director of player personnel Monti Ossenfort; Titans VP of player personnel Ryan Cowden; Chiefs chief executive director of player personnel Ryan Poles; Cardinals VP of player personnel Quentin Harris, Cardinals VP of pro personnel Adrian Wilson, 49ers assistant general manager Adam Peters and 49ers director of player personnel Ran Carthon.

Judge fired after 2 seasons with NYG

EAST RUTHERFORD, N.J. — The New York Giants have cleaned house, firing coach Joe Judge a day after general manager Dave Gettleman retired.

The Giants announced the move late Tuesday afternoon, ending some brief speculation that the owners planned to hire a new general manager and let him determine the 40-year-old coach's fate. Judge posted a 10-23 record in two seasons, including an embarrassing 4-13 mark this past season. The campaign ended with a six-game losing streak in which the offense did almost nothing with quarterback Daniel Jones sidelined with a neck injury.

Co-owners John Mara and Steve Tisch said they felt it was best for the Giants to move in another direction after five straight seasons of double-digit losses.

The Giants have made the playoffs once since winning the Super Bowl in February 2012. They have gone through four coaches in the past six seasons, starting with Ben McAdoo in 2016, interim coach Steve Spagnuolo, Pat Shurmur in 2018 and Judge who was hired in 2020.

Mara said he met with Judge on Monday and again on Tuesday, informing him of the decision at the second meeting.

"I said before the season started that I wanted to feel good about the direction we were headed when we played our last game of the season. Unfortunately, I cannot make that statement, which is why we have made this decision," Mara said.

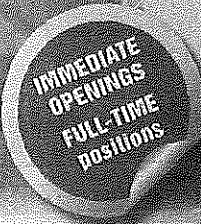

are working together to smoothly complete the transition statewide by June 30, 2022.

“It’s a new era of driver licensing in Kentucky,” Gov. Andy Beshear said. “We are using technology to offer more service options than ever before, such as online appointment scheduling, online license renewal, and mail-in renewal. After many years of issuing driver licenses, circuit court clerks will be able to focus solely on court business, and driver licensing will be executed at new regional offices whose only business is licensing.”

Making the transition in January along with Logan are will be Breckinridge, Jefferson, Meade, Todd, Trigg, and Trimble counties. Eighty-seven counties will have made the transition by the end of January.

“When I took office in January 2019, the statewide plan was for Circuit Court Clerks to continue to issue standard driver’s licenses and identification cards under the authority of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, and to work with KYTC to become compliant with the Federal REAL ID mandates,” said Logan

County Circuit Court Clerk Mary Orange. “However, shortly thereafter in mid-2019, with the Federal REAL ID deadlines looming and multiple implementation roadblocks, a decision was made between the Administrative Office of the Courts, KYTC, and KACCC that it was in the best interests of the citizens of Kentucky for KYTC to assume the role as issuer of all driver’s licenses and identification cards. Legislative changes followed, and in a few short months, all 120 Circuit Court Clerk’s offices around the state will cease to issue credentials.”

Starting Jan. 24, 2022, Logan County residents will be able to visit any regional KYTC office, renew by mail-in-form, or online at drive.ky.gov., said Orange. There will also be a mobile KYTC unit that will come to Logan County on a regular basis. Both written and road tests will be scheduled through the Kentucky State Police at kentuckystatepolice.org/driver-testing with testing to be held in Bowling Green.

“For quite some time, Kentucky has been the only state in the nation that has an elected Circuit Court Clerk issuing credentials. Other states have a DMV. I am an elected constitutional officer and

my duties are to manage the official court records of the District and Circuit Courts of Logan County,” said Orange. “My deputies and I are funded through the Judicial Branch (KCOJ) budget administered by AOC. As soon as it was determined that this transition would occur, AOC began to cut positions as they became vacant. Logan County lost our designated driver’s license position approximately a year ago. The effect is that this statewide transition is being implemented without the layoff of any deputy clerks. My office will continue to function as normal performing our constitutional duties receiving and recording lawsuits and court documents, providing forms and other legal materials, bench clerking for our Judges as needed, maintaining the digital record during motion hours and trials, collecting and disbursing fines, bonds, and other court-related funds, and maintaining the jury system.”

Orange added, “Change can be challenging. Since 1976 Kentucky citizens have been able to come to their local Circuit Court Clerk for their driver’s licenses and identification cards. However, I am confident that between the efforts of Circuit Court Clerks across the state, and the advancement of

services that KYTC has rolled out (such as the online renewal option), that this will be a smooth transition. Logan County residents are welcome to come to my office for assistance using the online renewal option, or for KYTC mail-in forms.”

Residents of counties making the transition may renew or apply for a REAL ID or new standard card version of driver license, learner permit, commercial driver license (CDL), or ID card at any KYTC Driver Licensing Regional Office. Applicants are encouraged to make an appointment online, which can be done at drive.ky.gov | Regional Offices Map. Walk-in customers are welcomed on a first-come, first-served basis until available slots are filled.

To date, more than 62,000 Kentuckians have skipped a trip to a regional office by renewing their current license online, and more than 3,500 have done so by mail.

KYTC regional offices, the only place where Kentuckians can get a REAL ID, are currently operating in Bowling Green, Burlington, Catlettsburg, Columbia, Elizabethtown, Frankfort, Jackson, Lexington, Louisville/Bowman Field (appointment only), Louisville/Dixie Highway (appointment only), Louisville/Hurstbourne, Louisville/Nia Center, Madi-

sonville, Manchester, Morehead, Owensboro, Paducah, Prestonsburg, Richmond, and Somerset, with more offices planned.

Driver Licensing Regional Offices will offer the following:

Online appointment scheduling. Walk-in customers are still welcome.

A choice between a REAL ID and a new standard card version. Both feature security upgrades and are available with a choice of four-year or eight-year expiration. (Eight years for all CDLs.)

Service at ANY regional office, regardless of customer’s county of residence.

Periodic Pop-up Driver Licensing visits to counties without a regional office to offer on-site application and renewal services.

License applicants receive a temporary identification document at the end of the transaction for use until the permanent card arrives by mail at their home address. This reduces the wait time for printing credentials during visits and improves security by eliminating in-office card production machinery.

A full list of counties that have transferred services to regional offices is available at drive.ky.gov | Circuit Clerks.

DRIVER TESTING

Kentucky State Police will continue to adminis-

ter all permit and license testing. Testing services are offered Monday through Friday by appointment. Applicants who require testing by KSP for a permit, driver’s license, or CDL may make an appointment online by visiting http://kentuckystatepolice.org/driver-testing/.

REAL ID

Kentucky will continue offering the option of a standard drivers license, but a REAL ID or other forms of federally approved identification, such as a passport or Department of Defense-issued military ID, eventually will be needed by people 18 and older for boarding commercial flights and accessing military bases and federal buildings that currently require identification. Enforcement is scheduled to begin May 3, 2023.

First-time application for a REAL ID must be made in person at a Driver Licensing Regional office. Specific documentation is required. A list of acceptable documentation and a link to take an interactive quiz that populates a personalized list of documents is available at drive.ky.gov | IDocument Guide.
