2. State all assumptions that Bluegrass Water used to develop its forecasted test-period financial information.

Response

Please refer to the notes tab in the various workpapers filed in response to 1 PSC 1 for the statement of assumptions.

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Request

3. Provide Bluegrass Water's and CSWR, LLC's (CSWR) internal accounting manuals, directives, and policies and procedures.

Response

The Company utilizes the NARUC Uniform System of Accounts manuals with the included accounting instructions as its policies and procedures. The versions used are those available on the website of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.

4. Provide Bluegrass Water's and CSWR's budget instructions, assumptions, directives, manuals, policies and procedures, timelines, and descriptions of budget procedures.

Response

The Company's budget process has not been formalized into a manual. The budget process Bluegrass uses for existing operations includes an examination of operating history and a review of contracts and agreements that set expenditure levels, which, when possible, are obtained through a competitive bid process. Multiple competitive bids also are obtained to help set budgets for capital projects. For new acquisitions, budgets are set based on bids received for operations and engineering estimates of necessary capital improvements. These amounts are assessed for reasonableness based on the Company and its affiliates' operating history at similar plants, some of which are in other jurisdictions.

5. Provide a rate base, capital structure, and statement of income for Bluegrass Water for the most recent actual 12-month period at the time of the company's application for rate adjustment and for the base period used in the company's application. Provide detailed explanations necessary to reconcile this information with the filed base-period revenue-requirement information.

Response

The rate base, capital structure, and statement of income for the base period used in the Company's application are provided in the schedules attached to the testimony of Brent Thies (Schedule B1 and Schedule C1) and the Company's response to 1 PSC 23.

At the time of the application, the Company did not have a full 12-month period of actuals to report due to closing on the Company's first round of systems mid-late September 2019. Similarly, the Company had yet to own eight (8) of the systems at the time of the application and still has not closed on four (4) of the systems.¹

¹ Bluegrass closed on the systems in Case No. 2020-00028 on November 19, 2020. While the Commission recently approved acquisition of the systems in Case No. 2020-00297 by its January 14, 2021 Order, Bluegrass has not yet been able to close on these systems.

10. Describe the procedures that Bluegrass Water uses to plan and approve construction projects.

Following execution of a purchase agreement, Bluegrass engages a contract engineer to

Response

perform an initial evaluation of each water or wastewater system that Bluegrass proposes to acquire. These engineers prepare a memorandum detailing the condition of the system, its compliance history, the capacity to treat wastewater or provide drinking water, issues requiring improvement, and recommended improvements for the system. The memorandum also includes a preliminary estimate of the cost of required improvements. Following closing on each system, the Bluegrass internal engineering team tours each site, reviews the memoranda and determines if the proposed improvements are practical and cost effective. Bluegrass also determines available alternatives to remedy identified problems at a reduced cost. The post-closing investigation of each facility and initial operation of each system allows Bluegrass to gather additional information about the condition of each facility beyond what the memorandum and compliance history indicates. This can lead to changes in the scope of improvements being considered, as some proposed improvements from the memorandum may prove unnecessary, while other necessary improvements may be discovered. Improvements are then categorized as either triage repairs (which will be addressed immediately because required work consists of repairs or direct replacement of damaged equipment, not requiring outside engineering design or permitting, and repairs necessary to address a critical failure) or secondary improvements (tasks that are either less

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urgent repairs or are highly technical repairs requiring outside engineering design services and/or permitting to complete). An external engineering contractor (typically the same firm used for the preparation of the memoranda) completes the design and permitting process required for any additional improvements and the projects are typically organized into bid packages when practical. Reputable contractors are solicited for bids on the improvements and the contract is awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible, qualified contractor for improvements to be implemented following permit approval.

Response

There are no written management contracts between or among Bluegrass Water, CSWR, and Central States Water Resources, Inc. Central States Water Resources, Inc., serves as the designated manager of CSWR and Bluegrass Water but is not compensated for those services. CSWR provides all administrative and support services for Bluegrass Water and its affiliated entities. A description of the services provided by CSWR can be found at page 11 of the direct testimony of Brent Thies.

14. Provide a copy of all contracts, if any, between Bluegrass Water and any person or entity retained to perform billing or customer service for or on behalf of Bluegrass Water and all contracts between Bluegrass Water and any person or entity retained to operate Bluegrass Water's utility plant. Describe in detail any such agreements that have not been memorialized in writing.

Response

There are no such agreements that have not been memorialized in writing.

Contracts between Bluegrass Water and Midwest Water Operations, LLC ("Midwest Water") for O&M services relating to the systems acquired following the final Orders in PSC Case Nos. 2019-00104 and 2019-00360, respectively, were Exhibits 16-A and Exhibit 16-B to the Application filed 9/30/20 in this case. Bluegrass Water and Midwest Water have entered into a similar, third contract relating to the systems acquired following the final Order in PSC Case No. 2020-00028, attached to this Response as KY2020-00290_BW_0001-KY2020-00290_BW_0011. A contact between Bluegrass Water and Nitor Billing Services, LLC for customer-service functions was Exhibit 16-C to the Application.

Also attached to this Response, as KY2020-00290_BW_0012- KY2020-00290_BW_0014 is a redacted copy of a contract between Central States Water Resources, Inc. and Starnik Systems, Inc. (Starnik) by which Starnik licenses billing services for Bluegrass Water and other of its affiliated utility-service companies. Confidential treatment for the redacted information is being sought in a concurrently-filed motion.

AGREEMENT REGARDING OPERATION OF UTILITY TREATMENT FACILITIES WASTEWATER

This Agreement Regarding Operation of Utility Treatment Facilities ("Agreement") is entered into and shall be effective as of the 14th day of October, 2020 ("Effective Date"), by and between **BLUE GRASS UTILITY OPERATING COMPANY**, **LLC.**, a Kentucky limited liability company ("Owner") and **Midwest Water Operations**, a Kentucky LLC ("Operator"), collectively the "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Owner, or its affiliate, is the owner for the operation, maintenance, and modernization of the wastewater treatment facilities, located in Kentucky known as: Arcadia Pines, Carriage Park, Marshall Ridge, and Randview.

WHEREAS, Operator provides the services of an operator, certified by the appropriate regulatory authority, as required, for wastewater utility treatment facilities, along with staff and equipment, to operate and maintain wastewater utility treatment facilities in Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the Owner, wishes to retain Operator, and Operator desires to provide services to the Owner related to the operation of the Facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the Parties agree as follows:

ENGAGEMENT; TERM; TERMINATION

- 1. Engagement. The Owner hereby engages Operator to provide services to the Owner related to the operation of the Facilities, as more particularly described herein, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. Operator hereby accepts such engagement and agrees (i) to perform all services necessary to operate and maintain the Facilities, including, without being limited to, those services specifically set forth in this Agreement and any attachment hereto; and (ii) to use reasonable and diligent efforts and to exercise the highest degree of professional competence in the performance of such services, in all cases, subject to the terms of this Agreement and any requirements of the Owner with regard to the operation of the Facilities.
- 2. <u>Term.</u> The term of this Agreement shall be effective as of the Effective Date and shall continue in full force and effect, unless sooner terminated as provided for herein, for a period of two (2) years.
- 3. <u>Termination of Agreement Without Cause</u>. Neither the Owner nor the Operator may terminate this Agreement without cause.
- 4. <u>Termination of Agreement With Cause</u>. The Owner or Operator may terminate this Agreement upon written notice in the event of the failure by the other Party to perform in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. The nonperforming Party shall have ten (10) days

from the date of the termination notice to cure or submit a plan for cure acceptable to the other Party.

- 5. Delay in Performance. Neither Owner nor Operator shall be considered in default of this Agreement for delays in performance caused by circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the nonperforming Party. For purposes of this Agreement, such circumstances include, but are not limited to, abnormal weather conditions, floods, earthquakes, fire, epidemics, war, riot, and other civil disturbances, strikes, lockouts, work slowdowns, and other labor disturbances, sabotage, judicial restraint, and inability to procure permits, licenses, or authorizations from any local, state or federal agency for any of the permissions, supplies, materials, accesses, or services required to be provided by either Owner or Operator under this Agreement. Should such circumstances occur, the nonperforming Party shall, within a reasonable time of being prevented from performing, give written notice to the other Party describing the circumstances preventing continued performance of this Agreement.
- 6. Termination Duties. Upon the termination of this Agreement, Operator shall render to the Owner a final accounting which shall cover the period from the date of the last statement rendered to the Owner. The Operator shall also forthwith (i) deliver copies of all records and reporting documents not already provided to the Owner, as well as, all materials, supplies, contracts, documents, accountings, papers and any and all other reports pertaining to the operation of the Facilities or this Agreement in the possession or under the control of Operator, and (ii) assign to the Owner, or its designee, existing contracts (previously approved by the Owner) in Operator's name, if any, relating to the operation of the Facilities. Within ten (10) days of the effective date of termination of this Agreement, the Owner shall forthwith pay to Operator all compensation then due Operator.

COMPENSATION TO OPERATOR

- 7. Operator Fee for Basic Services. In connection with Operator providing those services to the Owner related to the operation of the Facilities, and as more particularly described hereinbelow, and incorporated herein by this reference, the Owner shall pay to Operator a monthly fee of Twelve Thousand and Four Dollars (\$12,004.00).
- 8. Additional Fee Charged for Services Outside of Basic Scope of Services. In the event the Owner requests Operator to provide additional services not included under the Scope of Services as described herein below, Operator shall be compensated for such additional services in accordance with Operator's Prevailing Fee Schedule as follows:

Operator Fee for out of Scope Services \$70.00/Hour Operator OT Fee for out of Scope Services \$105.00/Hour Operator Fee for Operational Emergencies \$70.00/Hour

Reimbursement of Out-of-Pocket Expenses. Operator shall be eligible for reimbursement for any and all documented costs paid by Operator associated with the testing services, electrical, mechanical and/or other parts purchased to repair

and/or maintain the Facilities, chemicals required to operate the Facilities, and other out-of-pocket expenses required for the operation of the Facilities that are outside of the scope of the services for which the Operator is being paid the Fee for Basic Services. Prior approval by the Owner is required for all reimbursable expenses. Unless otherwise agreed by Owner, there will be no mark-up, handling charge or other such service fee(s), related to out-of-pocket expenditures and a copy of the original receipt(s) or other proof of purchase acceptable to Owner will be furnished with the reimbursement invoice. Reimbursement requests that were not approved in advance or are not accompanied by suitable proof of purchase may not be honored by Owner.

- 9. Payment of Fee and Reimbursable Costs. Operator shall submit to the Owner invoices for all Operator fees and claimed reimbursable costs on a monthly basis. All such invoices shall be due and payable to Operator by the Owner within thirty (30) days of the date of the invoice. Operator agrees that payment for claims for reimbursable expenses not received by Owner within sixty (60) days of the date incurred are at the discretion of the Owner. Invoices will be delivered to: ap@cswrgroup.com, or as provided in Section 20.
- 10. <u>Collection Costs</u>. If the Owner fails to make payments when due, Operator shall provide written notice to the Owner allowing the Owner fifteen (15) days to cure the default in payment. However, if after the fifteen (15) day cure period the Owner continues to fail to make payment to Operator, and Operator incurs any costs in order to collect the overdue sums from the Owner, the Owner agrees that all such documented collection costs incurred by Operator shall immediately become due and payable to Operator.

RESPONSIBILITIES - OWNER

- 11. Maintaining Permits. Owner shall keep all required permits up to date for the Facilities.
- 12. Payment of Fees Required by Government Authorities. Owner shall pay the annual operating fees, permit renewal fees, construction fees, testing fees, and any and all other fees as required by the governmental authorities for the operation of the Facilities.
- 13. <u>Damages Caused by Bypass</u>. Owner shall be responsible for and shall hold Operator harmless from liability for damages caused by a bypass of the Facilities or failure of the Facilities to meet the required effluent limits.
- 14. <u>Maintenance of Records</u>. Owner shall maintain all records on the operation and maintenance of the Facilities for a period of five (5) years or such additional period of time required by Kentucky State law.

RESPONSIBILITIES - OPERATOR

15. <u>Basic Services</u>. Operator shall provide to Owner the services set forth on the attached **EXHIBIT A**, which by this reference is incorporated herein.

- 16. Additional or Emergency Services. Any services not listed above shall be considered additional or emergency services. Additional Services are not included as part of the Basic Services and shall be paid for by Owner in accordance with the Operator's fee schedule set forth hereinabove.
- 17. <u>Standard of Care</u>. The standard of care of all services performed or furnished by Operator under this Agreement will be the care and skill ordinarily used by operators practicing under similar conditions at the same time and in the same locality.
- 18. Insurance. Operator shall procure and maintain in effect throughout the duration of the term of this Agreement insurance coverage not less than the types and amounts specified below. The Operator also agrees to furnish the Owner, from time to time and on demand, with suitable evidence that such insurance is in force. In the event that additional insurance, not specified herein, is required by Owner during the course of the services covered by this Agreement, Operator shall supply such insurance and all additional costs shall be borne by Owner. Policies containing a self-insured retention will not be acceptable to Owner. A company with an A- or better rating must issue all insurance policies. All coverage required herein shall list Owner as an additional insured including ongoing operations and completed operations on a primary and non-contributory basis using form CG 20 10 11 85 or its equivalent, and Operator shall maintain all coverage in force continuously without interruption during the term of this Agreement, except as set forth below with respect to tail coverage. In addition, each coverage required herein shall include a waiver of subrogation (where allowable by law).
 - (a) Comprehensive General liability insurance on an "occurrence basis," in the amount of at least \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, with at least a \$2,000,000.00 annual aggregate limit, including broad form property damage, blanket contractual and personal injuries (including death resulting therefrom) coverage.
 - (b) Automobile Liability insurance in the amount of \$500,000.00 per person and \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence for bodily injury and \$500,000.00 per occurrence for property damage or \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit. Coverage should extend to any auto or owned, hired or non-owned autos.
 - (c) Worker's Compensation and Employers Liability in the amount required by law.
 - (d) Commercial Umbrella Coverage on all of the foregoing coverage in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$5,000,000.00 aggregate.
 - (e) Operator shall maintain in force Pollution Legal Liability policy with limits of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 aggregate. In the event that Pollution Liability Coverage is discontinued for any reason by Operator after the termination of this Agreement, Operator agrees to procure tail coverage in force continuously without interruption for a period of three (3) years from the date of the termination of this Agreement.
 - (f) Professional Liability Error and Omissions coverage of not less than \$1,000,000.00

per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 aggregate. In the event that Professional Liability Errors and Omissions coverage is discontinued for any reason after the termination of this Agreement, Operator agrees to procure tail coverage in force continuously without interruption for a period of three (3) years from the date of the termination of this Agreement.

The policies listed above shall include within their certificate an endorsement that the policy may not be canceled until sixty (60) days prior written notice of cancellation has been served upon Owner by registered or certified mail.

Indemnification: Operator shall to the fullest extent of the law defend, indemnify and hold harmless Owner and all of its parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates and subcontractors, including their respective officers, directors, employees, principals, partners, agents, successors and assigns, (collectively "Indemnitees") from and against any and all actions, suits, arbitrations, administrative proceedings, demands and claims for any and all damages, injunctive or any other relief based on any cause of action whatsoever (sometimes individually "Claim" and sometimes collectively "Claims"), that may be brought or made against, or incurred by, Indemnitees on account of liabilities, damages, losses, cost, expenses, settlements, judgments, awards, and governmental penalties and sanctions, including reasonable attorneys' fees and experts' fees, including those attributable to bodily injury (including death), personal injury and property damage (sometimes individually "Liability" and sometimes collectively "Liabilities"), caused by, arising out of, or contributed to by any negligence, acts, errors, omissions or conduct of Operator, its employees, subcontractors, or agents, related in any way to the performance of any and all services described herein, except to the extent the Claims or Liabilities are determined to have been caused by the negligent or the willful misconduct of the Owner. Such obligation shall not be construed to negate, abridge, or reduce other rights or obligations of indemnity that would otherwise exist as to a party or person described in this Agreement.

Operator shall provide to Owner at execution of this Agreement a certificate of insurance showing all required endorsements and additional insureds.

NOTICES

20. Notices. Any notice, demand, consent, approval, request or other communication, required or permitted to be given hereunder, shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been delivered (i) on the day personally delivered, (ii) upon receipt if sent by overnight courier, (iii) on the third business day following its mailing by registered or certified mail (return receipt requested), postage prepaid, by deposit in the United States mail, or (iv) on the day received (if received by 5:00 p.m. local time on a business day at the location of the recipient [i.e., any day other than a Saturday or Sunday or Kentucky state (depending on the recipient's location) or federal holiday] and if not so received then on the next business day) if sent by facsimile or electronic transmission with proof of successful transmission.

- 21. <u>Information Provided by Others</u>. Owner shall furnish, at Owner's expense, all information, requirements, reports, data, surveys and instructions required by this Agreement. Operator may use such information, requirements, reports, data, surveys and instructions in performing its services and is entitled to rely upon the accuracy and completeness thereof.
- 22. Relationship of Parties. The Operator is and will remain for the term of this Agreement an independent contractor completely responsible for its own acts and for the manner in which, and the form by which, it performs this Agreement, and as such shall set its own hours and means and methods and shall not be subject to the supervision and control of the Owner except as to the results obtained. In no event shall the relationship created by this Agreement constitute a joint venture or partnership between the Owner and the Operator. Neither Party is authorized to assume or create any obligation or responsibility on behalf of, or in the name of, the other or bind the other in any manner whatsoever whether as agent, legal representative or otherwise.
- 23. Third Party Rights. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed to give any rights or benefits to anyone other than Owner and Operator.
- 24. <u>Waiver</u>. A waiver by either Owner or Operator of any breach of this Agreement shall be in writing. Such a waiver shall not affect the waiving party's rights with respect to any other or further breach.
- 25. Severability. The invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement or the occurrence of any event rendering any portion or provision of this Agreement void shall in no way affect the validity or enforceability of any other portion or provision of this Agreement. Any void provision shall be deemed severed from this Agreement, and the balance of this agreement shall be construed and enforced as if this Agreement did not contain the particular portion or provision held to be void. The parties further agree to amend this Agreement to replace any stricken provision with a valid provision that comes as close as possible to the intent of the

stricken provision. The provisions of this Section shall not prevent this entire Agreement from being void should a provision, which is of the essence of this Agreement, be determined void.

- 26. <u>Survival</u>. Notwithstanding completion or termination of this Agreement for any reason, all rights, duties and obligations of the parties to this Agreement shall survive such completion or termination and remain in full force and effect until fulfilled.
- 27. <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. Owner and Operator each binds itself and its successors, assigns, and legal representatives to the other party to this Agreement and to the successors, assigns, and legal representatives of such other party in respect to all provisions of this Agreement.
- 28. Assignment. The Operator shall not assign any rights or duties under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the Owner, which shall not be unreasonably withheld. However, the Owner shall be free to assign the rights and/or duties under this Agreement to any successor in interest by providing written notice to the Operator setting forth the name and contact information for the assignee and the date that the assignment will become effective. Nothing contained in this Section shall prevent Operator from employing independent Operators, associates, and subcontractors to assist in the performance of the Services.
 - 29. Controlling Law. The laws of the State of Kentucky shall govern this Agreement.
- 30. Anti-bribery, Anti-corruption and OFAC Compliance. The Owner takes a zero-tolerance approach to bribery and corruption. By executing this Agreement the Operator expressly acknowledges that all employees, agents, contractors and sub-contractors of the Operator must at all times comply with all applicable anti-bribery and anti-corruption laws and Operator policies and related procedures in relation to anti bribery and anti-corruption as set out herein or as may be implemented or amended from time to time and which will be made available for review upon request. Operator agrees to comply with the following policies:
 - Operator may not provide or receive anything of value to obtain or retain business or favored treatment from public officials; candidates for office; employees of state-owned enterprises; employees or officers of counterparties, clients/customers, or suppliers; any agent of the aforementioned parties; or any other person with whom the Operator does or anticipates doing business.
 - The prohibition against providing "anything of value" to obtain or retain business or favored treatment includes improper payments, such as cash bribes or kickbacks, but also may include other direct or indirect benefits and advantages, such as inappropriate gifts, meals, entertainment, charitable contributions, and offers of employment or internships.

In addition, the Owner is committed to combating money laundering, terrorist financing, securities fraud and other financial crimes (collectively "money laundering") and complying fully with all applicable laws and regulations relating to combating money laundering. The Owner is also committed to complying with economic and trade sanctions administered and enforced by governments and supranational bodies, including, among others, the sanctions programs and

designated sanctions lists administered by the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control ("OFAC"), the United Nations Security Council, the European Union and Her Majesty's Treasury. Compliance by employees, agents, contractors and sub-contractors of the Operator with all applicable anti-money laundering laws and regulations and sanctions programs and lists (collectively, "AML") is strictly required as a condition of this Agreement. Operator's participation with any employee, agent, contractor and/or sub-contractor of the Owner to engage in money laundering, or to fail to comply with all applicable AML laws, regulations, and Owner's AML policies, will be a breach of this Agreement, and will be cause for immediate termination of this Agreement by the Owner.

- 31. Executed Counterparts/Facsimile Signatures. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be deemed to be an original and all of which counterparts taken together shall constitute but one and the same instrument. Signature pages may be detached from the counterparts and attached to a single copy of this Agreement to physically form one document. This Agreement may be executed by a Party's signature transmitted by facsimile or electronic transmission, and copies of this Agreement executed and delivered with facsimile signatures shall have the same force and effect as copies hereof executed and delivered with original signatures. The Parties hereto may rely upon facsimile signatures as if such signatures were originals. The Parties hereto agree that a facsimile signature page may be introduced into evidence in any proceeding arising out of or related to this Agreement as if it were an original signature page.
- 32. <u>Further Assurances</u>. From time to time, each Party shall execute and deliver such further documents and shall take such other action as the other Party reasonably may request in order to discharge and perform their obligations and agreements hereunder.
- 33. Time. Time is of the essence of each provision of this Agreement in which time is an element. Time in which any act provided by this Agreement is to be done shall be computed by excluding the first day and including the last, unless the last day is a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday under the laws of the States of Kentucky or the United States of America, and then it is also excluded. Unless the context otherwise requires, all periods terminating on a given day, period of days, or date shall terminate at 5:00 p.m. Central Time on that day or date and references to "days" shall refer to calendar days.
- 34. Attorneys' Fees. In the event of any legal proceeding between the Parties arising out of the subject matter of this Agreement, in addition to any other award to which it shall be entitled, the prevailing party shall be entitled to an award for the reasonable attorneys' fees and costs incurred by its in connection with such proceedings.
- 35. Entire Agreement. This Agreement, and all attachments hereto, is the entire Agreement between Owner and Operator. It supersedes all prior communications, understandings and agreements, whether oral or written. The paragraph titles used in this Agreement are for general reference only and are not part of the Agreement. Amendments to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by both the Owner and the Operator.

36. <u>Payments</u>. It is further mutually agreed between the parties hereto, that no payment made under this Agreement shall be deemed as conclusive evidence of the performance of this Agreement, either in whole or in part, and that no payment shall be construed to be an acceptance of defective work or improper performance or materials.

- 1. Maintain all required certificates, licenses and approvals required by the governing authorities to operate the Facilities;
- 2. Make minimum of 3 (for mechanical plants) or 1 (for lagoons) weekly visits to the treatment facility to monitor the operation of the Facilities in order to assure the Facilities are in compliance with all required standards of the governing authorities and those set forth in this Agreement or any attachments hereto;
- 3. Perform weekly inspections of the Facilities' components as described in the CMMS (computerized maintenance management system) or as needed to meet manufacturers' specifications and recommendations.
- 4. Perform monthly, quarterly, semiannual, annual duties of the Facilities' components as described in the CMMS (computerized maintenance management system) or as needed to meet manufacturers' specifications and recommendations.
- 5. Maintain all facility records included in CMMS;
- 6. Perform all routine scheduled work orders generated through CMMS;
- 7. Prepare and file the necessary reports to government regulators to maintain regulatory compliance and provide copy of same to Owner;
- 8. Obtain the sampling requirements for testing by the government regulators and/or the Owner;
- 9. Contact appropriate laboratories to provide adequate testing and reporting services for Owner;
 - a. Provide all test results to the Owner as early as possible.
 - b. Notify the Owner immediately via Email and Phone of any test results that are outside of regulatory or permit limits, represent a potential for a Notice of Violation, could result in a fine from a Regulatory agency, or could cause a negative impact on the public.
- 10. Contact and direct appropriate contractors to make repairs to the system as needed for operation.
- 11. Monitor all of the Facilities' system alarms and remote controls and contact Owner in the event of an alarm;
- 12. Maintain a 24-Hour 7 day per week maintenance and emergency service phone line for customer utility service disruption events;
- 13. Must respond to all customer calls and notifications within a 2-hr period of receiving call or notification;
- 14. Provide a 24-Hour on-call emergency utility service response for operations;
- 15. Perform Utility Locates;
- 16. Perform Operation and Maintenance Tasks (tracked via work orders in the CMMS system), for time and material, which may include but are not limited to:

CSWR has initiated discussions with third-party banks to assist Bluegrass Water in securing debt capital. Those discussions have indicated a need for a state-specific intermediary CSWR-affiliated capital company entity to be the borrower and to provide credit enhancement to the bank in the form of a pledge of the capital company's assets and a guarantee from CSWR. The capital company would then lend debt capital to Bluegrass Water, with security to be provided in the form of liens on Bluegrass Water's utility assets. The capital company is a bank requirement as well as an operational necessity and regulatory commission expectation, as the banks are requiring security beyond the assets of Bluegrass Water. The Kentucky-specific capital company is required to ensure Bluegrass Water's assets are ring-fenced and not pledged to secure loans for CSWR-affiliated utilities operating outside Kentucky. *See also*, Bluegrass Water's Response to 2 PSC 05, filed December 2, 2020 in Case No. 2020-00297.

To date, one of these banks has provided a proposed term sheet. Bluegrass acknowledges that any debt financing arrangements, including the term sheet and structure described in the preceding paragraph, would be subject to approval of a financing case with the Commission.

- a. Customer equivalents for non-volumetric classes were developed using proportions in current tariffs (e.g., 75% of residential rate in Brocklyn Utilities) and a standard customer equivalency for a 1" meter of water demand (2.5) for commercial customers.
- b. No calculations were used in developing these equivalencies.

- 35. Refer to the Testimony of Thies Testimony, page 9.
 - a. Explain how the present rate revenues of nonvolumetric and volumetric customers of the wastewater operations and the water operations for the current and future customers (customers and systems applied to be acquired but have yet to be fully acquired) were calculated.

Calculations of present rate revenue are provided in the response to PSC DR 1 in Workbook SR-1 for Sewer Revenues and WR-1 for Water Revenue.

- a. For wastewater operations, the proposed rate for volumetric customers was calculated by increasing the current rate by the overall percentage increase (188.49%) for revenue requirement calculated in line 36 Schedule A (sewer) of Exhibit 21; the 2019 revenue for volumetric customers reported in the Delaplain 2019 Annual Report was increased by the same percentage to forecast revenues from the volumetric customers. Excluding the portion of the revenue requirement thus assigned to volumetric customers, the remaining portion of the revenue requirement was divided by the total number of residential equivalent customers served and by 12 months to determine the monthly revenue requirement of a single residential equivalent or a monthly unit cost. This monthly unit cost was then multiplied by the residential equivalency for each customer class to determine the proposed rate.
- b. Please refer to the amended Schedule M-1 and M-2 for water and sewer provided in the response to 1 PSC 32 for the calculations in Excel format.

Response

 - b. Explain if this turmoil in the market attributable to the COVID-19 pandemic is expected to continue once the vaccine is administered.

Response

- a. Market volatility remains elevated above historical averages despite vaccine announcements and the resolution of the US presidential election. As noted by S&P Global, since reaching a peak in mid-March, the VIX has flattened but remains persistently above pre-pandemic levels. This is in line with CBOE's expected volatility, which is projected to remain above historical averages until at least March 2022.
- b. Mr. D'Ascendis is not a public health expert, however there still appears to be a great deal of uncertainty relating to the COVID-19 pandemic around vaccine effectiveness, especially with the emergence of new UK strain of the virus, and timing of vaccine distribution. World Health Organization scientists have stated that "It's going to take till the end of 2021 till we start seeing some level of population immunity coming up in some countries." Given these factors and the VIX data cited above, Mr. D'Ascendis expects market volatility to remain elevated over historical averages in the near term.

- a. Because Mr. D'Ascendis did not rely on the requested data in his direct analysis, he does not have the requested information in his possession.
- b. Mr. D'Ascendis is not an employee of Value Line, and cannot speculate on how Value Line derived SJW Corp.'s projected EPS growth rate. As noted in Mr. D'Ascendis' direct testimony at page 22-23, he relies on a number of selection criteria to determine an appropriate proxy group of comparable, but not necessarily identical risk to Bluegrass Water. Based on the seven screens outlined in Mr. D'Ascendis' direct testimony, SJW Corp. fit the criteria to be included in the Utility Proxy Group.

40. Refer to the D'Ascendis Testimony, page 9. Provide an update of Chart 1 in Excel Spreadsheet Format with all rows and columns accessible and formulas unprotected.

Response

44. Refer to the D'Ascendis Testimony, pages 28–29. Provide a list of other regulatory agencies that explicitly approved the Predictive Risk Premium Model and the corresponding docket number.

Response

Mr. D'Ascendis's understanding is that the PRPM has been accepted by the Public Service Commission of South Carolina. In reviewing Docket No. 2017-292-WS, the Public Service Commission of South Carolina accepted Blue Granite Water Company's entire requested ROE, which included the PRPM. The relevant portion states:

"The Commission finds Mr. D'Ascendis' arguments persuasive. He provided more indicia of market returns, by using more analytical methods and proxy group calculations. Mr. D'Ascendis' use of analysts' estimates for his DCF analysis is supported by consensus, as is his use of the arithmetic mean. The Commission also finds that Mr. D'Ascendis' non-price regulated proxy group more accurately reflects the total risk faced [by] price regulated utilities and CWS. Furthermore, there is no dispute that CWS is significantly smaller than its proxy group counterparts, and, therefore, it may present a higher risk. An appropriate ROE for CWS is 10.45% to 10.95%. The Company used an ROE of 10.5% in computing its Application, a return on the low end of Mr. D'Ascendis' range, and the Commission finds that ROE is supported by the evidence."

Also, in Docket No. W-354, Subs 363, 364 and 365, the State of North Carolina Utilities Commission approved Mr. D'Ascendis's RPM and CAPM, which used PRPM analyses as presented in this proceeding. The relevant portion states:

"In doing so the Commission finds that the DCF (8.81%), Risk Premium (10.00%) and CAPM (9.29%) model results provided by witness D'Ascendis, as updated to use current rates in D'Ascendis Late-Filed Exhibit No. 1, as well as the risk premium (9.57%) analysis of witness Hinton, are credible, probative, and are entitled to substantial weight as set forth below."

 - b. Explain if such an adjustment is akin to the size premium adjustment used in many ROE applications. If not, explain why not.

Response

a. While Mr. D'Ascendis has not performed an exhaustive review of all past state regulatory commission decisions, he is aware that, in the proceedings noted below, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission acknowledged the increased risk associated with an electric utility's small size when setting the authorized ROE at the top end of the range of DCF results.

b. Yes, the company-specific business risk adjustment that Mr. D'Ascendis applies to Bluegrass Water's ROE calculation does consider the company's smaller size relative to the Utility Proxy Group, as noted in my Direct Testimony (p. 45-49) in addition to its extraordinary operating risk, as described by Mr. Cox in his direct testimony.

- 46. Refer to the D'Ascendis Testimony, Schedule DWD-3.
 - a. Refer to page 2 of 12. Provide a revision of the Predictive Risk Premium Model using the current risk free rate.
 - b. Refer to page 3 of 12. Provide a revision of the Risk Premium Derived Common Equity Cost Rate using the current yield on corporate and public utility bonds.

- a. As noted in Mr. D'Ascendis' direct testimony on page 39, it is his position that current risk-free rates are appropriate measure for utility ROE calculations as the cost of capital and ratemaking are prospective in nature. Because Mr. D'Ascendis did not rely on current interest rates in his analysis and does not think they are informative to the cost of common equity, he will decline to provide the requested information.
- b. Please see the response to part a, above.

- 47. Refer to the D'Ascendis Testimony, Schedule DWD-4.
 - a. Refer to page 1 of 2. Explain why the average of the mean and median Beta is used and if this is common practice for ROE analysis.
 - b. Refer to page 1 of 2. Provide an update to the Capital Asset Pricing Model (CAPM) using the current risk-free rate.

- a. Mr. D'Ascendis has consistently taken the average of the mean and median beta in order to incorporate all values but to mitigate potential low and high side outliers.
- b. Please refer to Mr. D'Ascendis' response to Request 47, part a.

48. Recognizing that the Water Proxy group is small, some ROE analysis for water utilities develop a combined utility proxy group of water and natural gas utilities. Explain if Bluegrass Water considered such an analysis and why it is not included in the instant application.

Response

Mr. D'Ascendis did not consider natural gas utilities in the Utility Proxy Group. As noted in his direct testimony at pages 22-23, Mr. D'Ascendis relies on a number of selection criteria to determine an appropriate proxy group of comparable risk to Bluegrass Water.

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Request

49. Confirm that no flotation costs were added to the ROE estimates.

Response

Correct, flotation costs were not considered in ROE calculations.

50. Some analysts believe that the current interest rate is the most efficient as it contains the most relevant information and since many interest rate forecasts are incorrect, using the current rate is most applicable. Provide Bluegrass Water's position regarding this opinion.

Response

As stated at page 29, line 19 through page 30, line 1 in Mr. D'Ascendis' direct testimony, since ratemaking and the cost of capital are prospective in nature, the use of prospective yields are essential.

51. For 2019 and 2020, provide all water utility ROE regulatory decisions as well as the source of this information.

Response

Because Mr. D'Ascendis did not rely on the requested data in his direct analysis, he does not have the requested information in his possession.

52. Refer to the Direct Testimony of Jennifer E. Nelson (Nelson Testimony), regarding the hypothetical capital structure, provide a list of other regulatory agencies that have approved a hypothetical capital structure and the corresponding docket number.

Response

As explained in Ms. Nelson's direct testimony at pages 5-7, a hypothetical ratemaking capital structure is appropriate for Bluegrass Water because its actual capital structure, and the capital structure of its parent, deviates substantially from industry practice. Moreover, as noted at page 7, the Company's proposed hypothetical capital structure is consistent with (1) its proposal approved in prior asset acquisition proceedings before the Commission and (2) its goal to have a 50/50 capitalization structure on average over time.

In Ms. Nelson's experience, although many regulatory commissions generally accept a utility's actual capital structure (unless it differs substantially from industry practice), it is not uncommon for regulatory commissions to authorize a capital structure to be used for ratemaking purposes that differs from the subject utility's actual capital structure. While she has not performed a comprehensive review of regulatory commission decisions, Ms. Nelson understands that it is not uncommon for small water utilities like Bluegrass Water to have actual capital structures consisting of 100% common equity and 0% debt and to be authorized a hypothetical capital structure to be used for ratemaking purposes. For example, Water Service Corporation of Kentucky is capitalized with 100% equity and 0% debt. In Case No. 2020-00160, the Commission utilized a debt ratio of 51.40% for Water Service Corporation of Kentucky for the purpose of calculating interest expense.

 - a. Provide an update to the current yield on B-rated and CCC-rated utility debt.
