Bluegrass Water's Motion for Confidential Treatment of Information

Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company, LLC ("Bluegrass Water"), respectfully submits this Motion pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, for confidential treatment of certain information responsive to the initial requests for information in this case. In support of this Motion, Bluegrass Water states as follows:

- 1. On this date, Bluegrass Water filed its Responses to Commission Staff's First Request for Information ("1 PSC __") and to the Attorney General's Initial Data Requests ("1 AG __").
- 2. Bluegrass Water is seeking confidential treatment for its responses to 1 PSC 14, 1 PSC 18, and 1 AG 39. 1 PSC 14 seeks production of any third-party agreements for billing and operating services; 1 PSC 18 seeks information regarding the compensation for the corporate officers and employee groups of Bluegrass affiliate CSWR; and 1 AG 39 seeks compensation information for the employees of Bluegrass affiliate CSWR.
- 3. Bluegrass Water provided the third party contract for the agreement of its affiliate, Central States Water Resources, Inc. ("CSWR") with Starnik Systems, Inc. (hereinafter "Starnik") attached as redacted KY2020-00290_BW_0011-KY2020-00290_BW_0014.

 Bluegrass Water has also provided a document with the CSWR officer and employee group compensation information (hereinafter "CSWR Corporate Officer/Employee Group

Compensation") attached as redacted KY2020-00290_BW_0078. Finally, Bluegrass Water has provided a document with the CSWR employee compensation information (hereinafter "CSWR Employee Compensation") attached as redacted KY2020-00290 BW 0407.

- 4. Confidential treatment is being sought for certain information in the Starnik contract, the CSWR Corporate Officer/Employee Group Compensation document, and the CSWR Employee Compensation document specifically, the dollar amounts contained therein in each of these documents. These documents for which confidential treatment is sought are contained in full in an unredacted copy submitted under seal.
- 5. All the documents herein for which confidential treatment is being sought are not publicly disseminated and public disclosure of this information would harm CSWR because these reveal sensitive information regarding the internal financial ability and workings of CSWR, a non-party who is not a utility nor is subject to regulation by the Commission. The sensitive, commercially-valuable, and financial information contained therein is not publicly distributed or disseminated outside of CSWR, and only disseminated internally to certain personnel with permission or a business reason to use it are permitted to view these documents, as well as sensitive personal information regarding the compensation of various employees. The redacted information in these documents for which confidential treatment is sought are treated as confidential by Bluegrass Water and its affiliates.
- 6. Under KRS 61.878(1)(c)(1), commercial information generally recognized as confidential is protected if disclosure would cause competitive injury and permits competitors an unfair commercial advantage. Public disclosure of the information in the documents for which Bluegrass Water seeks confidential treatment may cause competitive harm to CSWR in anticipated future acquisitions and operation of its systems in Kentucky.

- 7. If the Commission disagrees with Bluegrass Water that the material for which this Motion seeks confidential treatment is exempt from disclosure, it must hold an evidentiary hearing to protect the due process rights of Bluegrass Water and permit the opportunity to supply the Commission with a complete record to enable it to reach a decision with regard to this confidentiality request.
- 8. In compliance with 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 8(3) and 13(2)(3), Bluegrass Water is filing with the Commission a copy of the Starnik agreement, the CSWR Corporate Officer/Employee Group Compensation document, and the CSWR Employee Compensation document, entirely unredacted and with highlighting of the material for which confidential treatment is sought. The unredacted copies are filed under seal pursuant to the instructions regarding confidential filings in the 3/24/20 Order issued in Ky. PSC Case No. 2020-00085; redacted pages of the subject documents are being publicly filed with the electronic copy of this Motion.
- 9. Bluegrass Water would not object to the disclosure of the Starnik agreement, the CSWR Corporate Officer/Employee Group Compensation document, or the CSWR Employee Compensation document, pursuant to a confidentiality agreement with any intervenor who can demonstrate a legitimate interest in reviewing the confidential information for the purpose of participating in this proceeding.
- 10. 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(2)(a)(2) provides that a motion for confidential treatment shall state the time period in which the material should be treated as confidential and the reasons for this time period. Movant respectfully submits that five years from the date of the filing of this Motion is a reasonable period of time for these documents to be treated as confidential in light of the competitive conditions in the water and wastewater industry.

WHEREFORE, Bluegrass Water respectfully requests that the Commission grant confidential treatment of the information described herein.
